**COVID – 19 Update from Ohio Bishops**

After serious consideration of the grave health risk involved in public gatherings and in order to curb the spread of the coronavirus, the bishops of Ohio have decided, effective immediately, to **suspend temporarily all publicly celebrated Masses/liturgies, at least through the celebrations of Holy Week and Easter.** The bishops of Ohio dispense the Catholic faithful who reside in their respective dioceses and all other Catholics currently in Ohio from the obligation of attending Sunday Mass through Easter Sunday. Catholic bishops of Ohio, out of concern for the common good and the physical as well as spiritual well-being of all of the people of Ohio, have agreed to cooperate with the governor's direction to create "social distance".

Sunday and daily Masses can be viewed on EWTN at various times of the day. Sunday Masses are broadcast on WJW-TV FOX8 each week on Sunday at 6:00 a.m.

**Concerning Palm Sunday**

Fr. Tom will bless the Palms in a private service and then the palms will be placed inside the church where parishioners can pick them up any time during Holy Week.
