

HOMEBOUND MINISTERS

PROCEDURES FOR OUTDOOR MASS

- 1) **Before** you come to St. Clare Church, please do a home wellness screening.
- 2) **Before** Daily or Weekend Mass, arrive 15 minutes before Mass begins.
Proceed directly to the Check-in host.
Identify yourself as a Homebound Minister and request to sign in.
Fill out and complete required information in the Homebound Registry Binder
(If you are bringing Holy Communion to a family member please write down your name, address and phone number. A separate sign-in sheet will be available.)
- 3) Keep your Pyx with you until after Mass. If you need a **Gluten free host** please email Patty Murphy at pattym@stclareroseville.org. Let her know your request in advance so she can arrange this with the sacristan for that Mass.
- 4) As soon as you have completed your preparation before Mass go to your seat and prepare yourself with prayer.
- 5) After the conclusion of the Mass, a member of Clergy or a Lead EMHC will fill the open Pyxes with Consecrated Hosts. After Mass, stand by the left front door of the Church (6 feet apart) and the Deacon will bring the Consecrated Hosts out. When it is your turn, hold out your Pyx and the Deacon will place the Consecrated Host/s in it.
- 6) As soon as you have collected your Pyx, go directly to your Homebound Communicant or Family Member.
Please, please, do not stop or continue your day with errands that you had scheduled.
Please remember that Jesus Christ is in your Hands. Do not keep Jesus waiting....
Show our Lord all the respect and the Love He deserves from you.
- 7) At the home visit, make sure to wear a mask and sanitize hands prior to and after touching the Body of Christ and giving Holy Communion.
- 8) If you are age 65 and over and following guidelines to not attend live Masses at this time, you may come after Mass, sign in, fill out and complete required information in the Homebound Registry Binder. Get in line with the other Homebound Ministers waiting outside the Church to receive your Consecrated Host/s.
