Every Friday during Lent, we will be offering a Lenten Dinner in the Parish Hall. The Dinners will begin at 6:00pm and the Stations of the Cross will be given at approximately 6:45 - immediately after the meals. **The Lenten Meal for next Friday, March 24, 2017 is Meatless Soup beans, brown beans with dumplings, fried potatoes, macaroni and cheese, cornbread, fruit bowl and a drink. Any donation that you wish to make for the meal will be accepted. Everyone is invited to attend.**

Church Regulations for Fasting and Abstinence during Lent:

Everyone 14 years of age or older is bound to abstain from meat on all the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday. *Everyone 18 or older, and under 59 years of age, is bound to fast on Good Friday. * On Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. * Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.

The Parish Lenten Reconciliation Service will be held on Monday, April 3, 2017 at 7:00pm. Several Priests from our area will attend the service to hear confessions.



The Lenten "Good Deed" Project for our Religious Education Classes this Lenten Season is to prepare Easter baskets for the residents at the Clarksburg Mission as well as cooking and serving the residents breakfast. The students will be going to the Mission on April 2, 2017 to take the baskets and to cook and serve the breakfast. We are asking our parishioners to supply items needed to prepare the baskets. They are as follows: Men's socks, Women's Socks, general toiletry items, and candies and snacks.

The baskets are small, so please buy small sizes of items if you can. Monetary donations will also be accepted to purchase items for a few children's baskets as we understand that there are several child residents at the Mission. We ask that you bring the items to the church by March 31, 2017. They can be delivered any weekday from 9:00am to 1:00pm, with your child at CCD or deposit the items in the box after any mass.
