Every Friday during Lent, we will be offering a Lenten Dinner in the Parish Hall. The Dinners will begin at 6:00pm, and the Stations of the Cross will be given immediately after the meals at approximately 6:45pm. Next week’s Lenten meal is on March 2nd, and the menu is three types of fish, a variety of vegetables, desserts and drinks. Please note that the meal will be served at 6:00pm followed by stations of the cross at 6:45pm. Any donation that you wish to make will be accepted for the meals, and all are invited to attend.

Church Regulations for Fasting and Abstinence during Lent:

Everyone 14 years of age or older is bound to abstain from meat on all the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday. “Everyone 18 or older, and under 59 years of age, is bound to fast on Good Friday. “On Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one’s needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not apply. *Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.

All Services begin at 7:00pm
