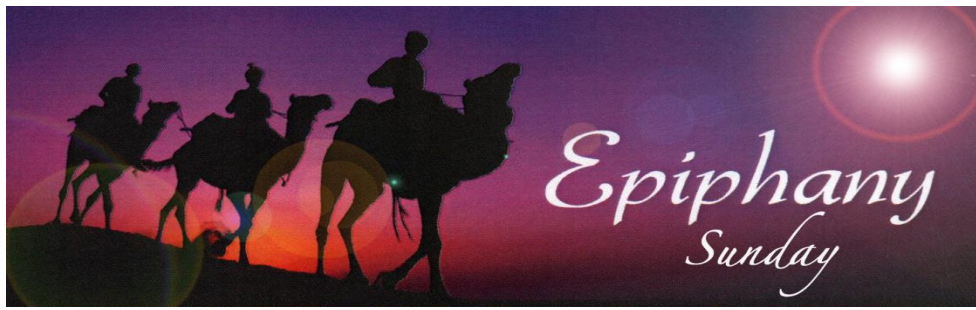

This Sunday is the Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord: In some parts of the world, it is observed with more solemnity than Christmas. The word "Epiphany" means revelation or manifestation of God's presence. It is sometimes called Feast of the Three Kings or Little Christmas. This Feast has been celebrated in the Eastern Church since the third Century. Tradition in the Eastern Church alludes to nine kings, not three. Some also say there may have been 2 or 4. Who knows? The Gospel however, only tells us about three gifts: gold, frankincense & myrrh brought by Magi. We can offer gifts of praise and faithfulness to the Lord. The Christmas Season ends this year on January 13th, the Baptism of the Lord.
