
St. Ann Penance Service will be held on Thursday, April 4, 2019 at 7:00pm. Several priests from this area will be at the service to hear confessions.

The miraculously incorrupt heart of St. John Vianney, endearingly known as the "Cure of Ars" and the patron saint of parish priests, will be coming to our diocese during Monday and Tuesday of Holy Week (April 15 and 16). The relic will be in Charleston at the Basilica of the Co-Cathedral of the Sacred Heart on Monday, April 15th, and the Cathedral of St. Joseph in Wheeling on Tuesday, April 16th. On both days, the relic will be available for veneration from 9am through to the completion of the Chrism Mass beginning at 4:00pm.

The Ladies of the Altar Society and our Parish have begun participating in the backpack program that supplies backpacks full of food for those children who rely on the school system for their meals. On the week-ends, these children often do not get to eat. The backpacks are a way to help these children.
