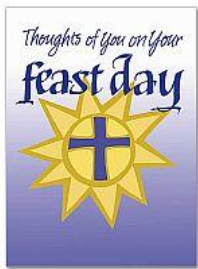

Since it is your ministry like any other ministry such as lector, altar server, CCD catechist, then it is your responsibility to find a substitute. Therefore, it is not the responsibility of the Parish Secretary who is currently coordinating the Adoration Chapel. (If anyone would like to accept the Chapel Coordinator Responsibilities, please feel free to stop in the office or call) One possibility is to have a current list of Adorers and subs. Call one of the substitutes who has agreed like you to be a part of this important ministry here.

Another possibility when needing a sub is to call either the person before you or right after you if they would be able to take an extra hour or half-hour for you. You know who comes before you and after you. Copies of the current list of people and their phone contacts are in the Chapel. Contact the parish office and request an updated list either by regular mail, email or pick one up from the chapel. There are extras in the folders on the table in the entryway. Please keep your phone numbers and emails current. Also, those who have taken the roll of “Substitute Adorers,” if you are no longer interested in this ministry, need a break or would like to become a sub, please contact the Parish Office. The Blessed Sacrament on Perpetual Exposition in a monstrance is never to be without someone present.
