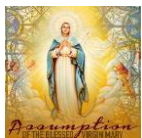

Notes from Fr. Gary: Over the last month, we have passed out all 100 copies of the book, *Letter to a Suffering Church*. When you are done, pass it on by encouraging someone else to read it or mail it to someone. In our 2 discussion sessions, we had 17 people who sincerely came together. The clarion call for the laity is not to be passive but active and even pro-active in building up the Body of Christ, a very rich image from St. Paul. One way is making the church even safer, esp. for our children. This is why the dioceses of the United States insist on every adult who is around children (including your grand and great-grandchildren) to go through our Safe Environment training involving 3 steps. We had an on-site training here on Sunday, June 23rd. Almost every liturgical minister has become fully compliant over these past weeks. (All of our CCD catechists are fully trained.) Thank you for your time, effort and support. There are a few who need to complete a step or two to become certified ASAP. This is a very concrete, specific effort so that ALL our liturgical ministers can be 100% on-board for our local faith community and our diocesan church. The second item that each of us can do is to continue advancing in our call to holiness, our individual spiritual lives which begun in the waters of Baptism, the very first sacrament that each Christian receives. Creating and maintaining a Safe Environment is everyone's responsibility, each member of our faith community.
