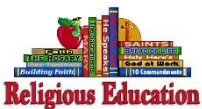

Please contact the office at least 6 months prior to the proposed date of marriage.

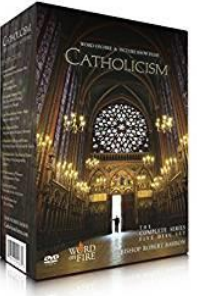

The Holy Name Society will meet Sunday Evening at 7:00pm. All men of the parish are encouraged to attend. **(Please note the time change)**

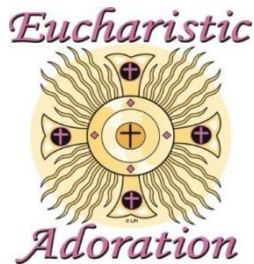
