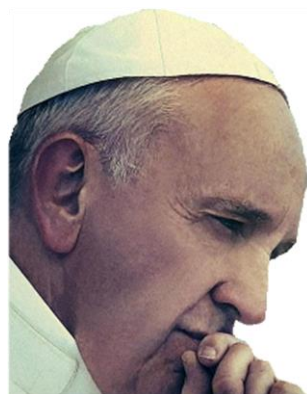
**This is an incredible opportunity for YOU to have a say in YOUR church!**

## WORLD MISSION SUNDAY IS NEXT WEEKEND



World Mission Sunday, the worldwide Eucharistic celebration for the Missions and missionaries of the world, is celebrated annually on the next to last Sunday in October, this year on Oct. 18. We are called to be part of the Church's missionary efforts, through prayer, self-sacrifice and support of missionary vocations through material aid.

In his message for World Mission Day 2020, entitled "Here I am, send me" (Is 6:8), Pope Francis writes, "In this year marked by the suffering and challenges created by the Covid-19 pandemic, the missionary journey of the whole Church continues in light of the words found in the account of the calling of the prophet Isaiah: 'Here am I, send me.' This is the ever new response to the Lord's question: "Whom shall I send?" This invitation from God's merciful heart challenges both the Church and humanity as a whole in the current world crisis."

Remembering that we are baptized and sent in Christ on mission in the world, we can pray for the Church's worldwide missionary work and offer financial help and charity. All donations to the World Mission Sunday collection go entirely to support churches, hospitals, schools and vocations in countries where the Church is new, young or poor, with a majority of these in Africa and Asia. The annual collection will be taken up in parishes on Oct. 17 and 18.
