According to the CDC, it's likely that not only will Covid continue spreading this fall and winter, but that flu viruses will now, as well. Therefore, it's not a time to get lax on safety protocols, according to Bishop Brennan. "We are still in the middle of it. West Virginia has seen an upsurge of cases recently, so we cannot afford to relax our vigilance."

For parishioners here at St. Ann's, that means masks MUST be worn upon entering the church and continue throughout the Mass. The masks must completely cover the mouth and nose. The only time they can be pulled away is when receiving communion. If you do not have a mask, the ushers can provide one. If you cannot wear a mask for health reasons, we ask that you please remain at home.

**CCD classes** will begin immediately following Mass on Sunday, Nov. 1. Classes will consist of one in-person session on the first Sunday of each month, during which social distancing protocols will be followed. Parents must supply a mask for their child. At that time, students will be given a packet of materials to be completed at home and returned at the next in-person session.

### A Message About Mass Intentions

Currently, with only two weekend masses, one intention is always offered for the people of the parish, which then leaves only one open intention for the presider/priest to remember. The person who requests a mass intention -- for the deceased, living or for various needs such as peace, reconciliation, health, healing and so on, does not have to be present when the petition is offered. One's physical presence is not a requirement, and maybe not even possible at this moment due to Covid, yet the graces and benefits of the mass are still given.
