Wednesday, Feb. 3, is the Feast of St. Blaise, who is venerated as the Patron Saint of Sufferers from Throat Diseases. According to tradition, Blaise, who was a physician and bishop, fled persecution and lived for many years in the hills, where he cared for sick animals. Blaise was later captured and, while imprisoned, cured a boy choking on a fish bone. He was later killed for refusing to denounce his faith and love in God. It is customary to bless throats on this day by extending crossed candles over a person while saying the following: "Through the intercession of Saint Blaise, bishop and martyr, may

God deliver you from every disease of the throat and from every other illness. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." As we go about another week given to us by God, let us, like St. Blaise, never be afraid to be bearers of God's love, always and in all ways. Peace!
