### A MESSAGE FROM BISHOP BRENNAN ON MAINTAINING COVID SAFETY PROTOCOLS

“With the celebrations of Holy Week and Easter fast approaching, I write to you regarding the safety protocols that have been in place since we resumed the public celebration of Masses in May 2020. Our general diocesan directives, as last updated in September 2020, remain in effect:

- Upon entering and throughout the Mass, wear a mask that covers your mouth and nose
- Follow strict physical distancing, only using every other pew and maintaining a 6-foot distance between individuals from different households.
- Ushers need to continue to take an active role to ensure physical distancing is maintained
- For the celebration of Funeral Masses, all of the requirements for the public celebration of a Mass should still be followed
- At each Mass, the names and contact information for all parishioners and visitors should continue to be recorded
