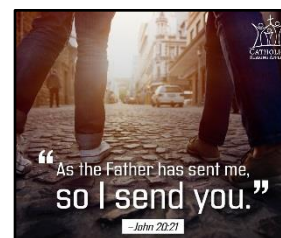
COMING UP NEXT ... their "Curbside Spaghetti Dinner" on April 25. Calls will go out soon for help with ingredient donations.
