

Covid Related Changes for Church

Effective May 17th, facemasks are no longer required in church. Of course, they may still be worn by those who are at higher risk of contracting the disease. Sanitizers are still available at the entrances for use, and will be used by all who assist in distributing communion. All churches are allowed to go back to 100% capacity without requirements of social distancing. Congregational singing is now allowed, and missals are allowed for use. Gift bearers are allowed as well as a return to the normal collection procedures.

Beginning on the weekend of May 29th and 30th, communion distribution will return to the old way before covid. The middle sections of the church approach down the center aisle and the wings approach the minister in their area. Missalettes will no longer be kept in the pews, but will be on two carts in the entrance of the church. You may pick up a missal from the cart before mass and please return it to the cart on your way out. Gift bearers will soon be assigned to bring up gifts, and as soon as we have our full contingent of ushers we will begin passing the basket as we did before.

Dispensation Lifted Per Bishop Nickless

Bishop Nickless is reinstating the obligation to attend mass on June 5/6, 2021. That is to say, all Catholics who have made first communion are obliged to attend Sunday (Saturday evening) mass EXCEPT for a serious reason such as illness, disability, advanced age, caring for a sick child, or no mass is available within reasonable distance.
