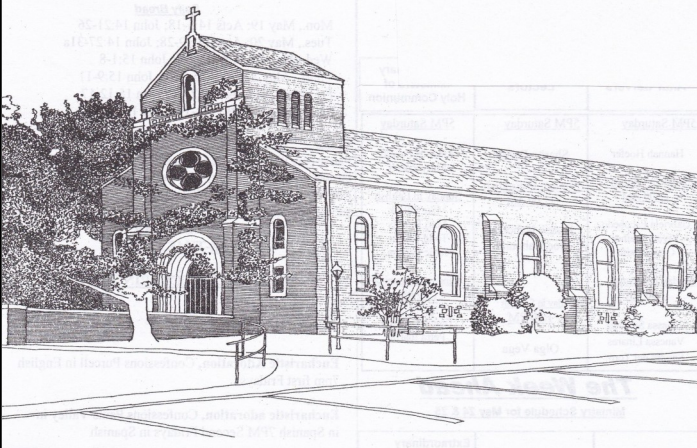




September 12th & 13th

Dear Parishioners,

Greetings to you from Fr. John Peter. Hope you are all feeling well.

This week I would like to write to you about the need of encouraging our children to be altar servers. Beginning the weekend of September 12th & 13th we will be scheduling the altar servers to serve for Mass. Altar serving provides an opportunity for young people to deepen their faith life and to learn more about the church. It is one of the most helpful services that young people can perform in the parish. The various tasks of the altar server include assisting with the book of prayers when the presider needs to read from it, helping to set the altar with the bread and wine, and carrying the candles, incense and processional cross. In order to become a server, a person has to have received the sacraments of baptism, reconciliation, and Eucharist and be in at least the third grade. Training is required. Studies and numbers have shown us that it is always from these young men and women who serve on the altar who tend to become Priests and Nuns as they have developed a thirst to serve God in a most noble way. I was an altar server at the age of 6 and it was during that time that I earned the desire to become a Priest which led me to join the seminary at the age of 12. Even if your children don't become Priests or Nuns, it is better to encourage them to develop a taste and thirst for God and to inculcate in them to have that fear of God. Many of the Priests today can reiterate how they can go back to their childhood days when they were altar servers and decided to undertake the journey of joining the seminary. Please call the Parish Office if you want to serve on the altar by becoming an altar server. Remember that you are doing a favor by encouraging your children to be altar servers.

Estimados feligreses,

Saludos de parte del P. Juan Pedro. Espero que todos se sientan bien.

Esta semana me gustaría escribirles sobre la necesidad de animar a nuestros niños a ser monaguillos. A partir del fin de semana del 12 y 13 de septiembre, programaremos a los monaguillos para que sirvan en la Misa. El servicio del altar brinda una oportunidad para que los jóvenes profundicen su vida de fe y aprendan más sobre la iglesia. Es uno de los servicios más útiles que los jóvenes pueden realizar en la parroquia. Las diversas tareas del monaguillo incluyen ayudar con el libro de oraciones cuando el celebrante necesita leerlo, ayudar a preparar el altar con el pan y el vino y llevar las velas, el incienso y la cruz procesional. Para convertirse en servidor, una persona debe haber recibido los sacramentos del bautismo, la reconciliación y la Eucaristía y estar al menos en tercer grado. Se requiere entrenamiento. Los estudios y las cifras nos han demostrado que son siempre estos hombres y mujeres jóvenes que sirven en el altar quienes tienden a convertirse en sacerdotes y monjas, ya que han desarrollado una sed de servir a Dios de la manera más noble. Yo era monaguillo a la edad de 6 años y fue durante ese tiempo que me gané el deseo de ser sacerdote, lo que me llevó a unirme al seminario a los 12 años. Incluso si sus hijos no se convierten en sacerdotes o monjas, pero es mejor animarlos a desarrollar el gusto y la sed de Dios e inculcarles el temor de Dios. Muchos de los sacerdotes de hoy pueden reiterar cómo pueden volver a los días de su infancia cuando eran monaguillos y decidieron emprender el viaje de unirse al seminario. Por favor llame a la Oficina Parroquial si quiere servir en el altar convirtiéndose en monaguillo. Recuerde que está haciendo un favor al animar a sus hijos a ser monaguillos. Dios nos bendiga a todos.
