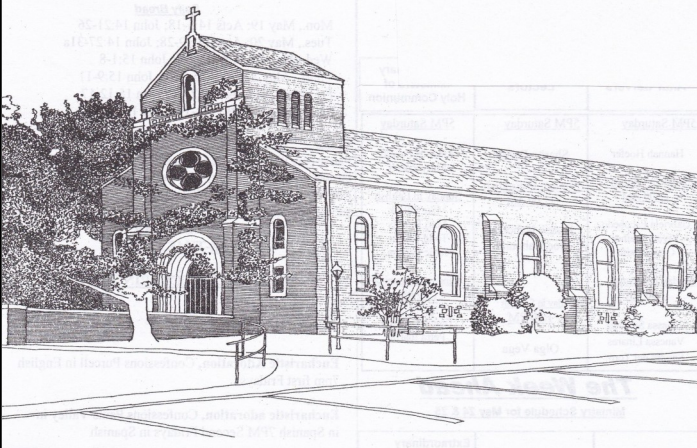

Dear Parishioners,

Greetings to you all from Fr. John Peter.

I hope that you are doing well. This week I want to write about the importance of daily Masses. I know well that when Fr. Jim was the pastoral administrator at our church, he was unable to celebrate daily masses in our church due to the fact that he was full time working at the university, and so we were not having daily mass celebrated in the church, but instead we had communion services. But since my appointment as the pastor of Our Lady of Victory Church, I have started to celebrate daily masses. That is, Tuesday at 9 a.m., Wednesday at 12 noon, Thursday at 7 p.m., which is a Spanish Mass, and Friday at 9 a.m. I gave different options of timings to accommodate different crowds who can come for daily Mass. On Wednesday we have noon mass so that we can give opportunity for the people who are working at local offices to attend the Mass during the lunch break. On Thursday I have scheduled 7 pm in Spanish to give opportunity for the Hispanic Community to come for daily Mass. I do understand that the concept of daily mass is something new as we have not had daily masses for a long time. Now the pandemic is not helping us either for people to come for daily mass leave alone the weekend masses. But still we have opportunities for the people who are unable to attend the weekend masses due to the large gathering, who can now attend the daily Masses if they prefer. In the weekly bulletin you will notice that we have no intentions for daily Masses or weekend Masse. That is because we don't have any mass intentions saved in the parish. Hence, we have no intentions for whom the Mass is to be celebrated. Hence, I am opening it to you all that if anyone wants to offer a daily mass for a particular intention you may do so by calling the office.

One of the greatest acts of charity is to pray for the living and the dead. The greatest and most powerful prayer we have is the Mass, since the fruits of the Mass are the very fruits of Jesus' redemption. For that reason, all are encouraged to have Mass offered for loved ones who have died, or even for the living who have some need. This is an ancient Catholic practice, and all are encouraged to take it up. A Mass intention may be requested for a Mass for: a deceased loved one; a living person who is sick or suffering; a living person who is celebrating a birthday, anniversary or other special moment in their life; in thanksgiving to God, or for any prayer intention. Requests will be honored on a first-come, first serve basis in the order in which the request is received at the Parish Office. A \$10 stipend, as determined by archdiocesan policy, is to accompany each Mass request. Requests for Mass Intentions must be made by calling the parish office with the particular intention or you can drop the written intention in the collection basket with the money in the envelope or can be mailed to the parish office. Please note that Mass intentions may be requested for Sundays, most holidays and weekdays throughout the year. One Mass every Sunday must be scheduled for the intentions of our parishioners known as Pro Populo (For the People) as required by Canon Law. Mass requests will be granted as close to the requested date and time as possible. If it is not possible to comply with the primary request, the next closest date and time will be scheduled.

I hope that you are familiar with the Mass intention policy and that you can call the parish office to have your mass intentions taken care. I hope that this note helps you to understand the notion of daily Mass and the intentions that go along with it.

Once again thank you to each of you for all that you are to the parish and for your financial contributions that sustain the parish ministries. Hope to see you all soon.

Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion

This is to let everyone know that those of you who wish to serve as Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion other than those who are currently serving should contact Fr. John Peter and make a formal request. This also includes those who want to take communion to homebound or nursing homes. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion do not serve automatically or by volunteering. The pastor must invite qualified candidates to serve, and they must be approved and appointed by the Archbishop.

Qualifications of Candidates

1. Candidates must be mature, practicing Catholics who, ordinarily, are at least eighteen years of age.
2. Candidates should have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.
3. Candidates who are converts should be active members of the Church for at least three years.
4. Candidates who are married must be in a valid marriage.
5. Candidates must not be under any censure.
6. The public life of the candidate must reflect the teachings of the Church.

The Deadline is October 5th, 2020

Ministro Extraordinario de la Sagrada Comunión

Esto es para que todos sepan que aquellos de ustedes que deseen servir como Ministros Extraordinarios de la Sagrada Comunión que no sean los que actualmente están sirviendo deben comunicarse con el P. John Peter y haz una solicitud formal. Esto también incluye a aquellos que quieren llevar la comunión a hogares confinados o asilos de ancianos. Los Ministros Extraordinarios de la Sagrada Comunión no sirven de manera automática o voluntaria. El pastor debe invitar a candidatos calificados para servir, y deben ser aprobados y designados por el Arzobispo.

Cualificaciones de los candidatos

1. Los candidatos deben ser católicos maduros y practicantes que, por lo general, tienen al menos dieciocho años de edad.
2. Los candidatos deberían haber recibido el Sacramento de Confirmación.
3. Los candidatos convertidos deben ser miembros activos de la Iglesia durante al menos tres años.
4. Los candidatos que estén casados deben estar en un matrimonio válido.
5. Los candidatos no deben estar bajo ninguna censura.
6. La vida pública del candidato debe reflejar las enseñanzas de la Iglesia.
