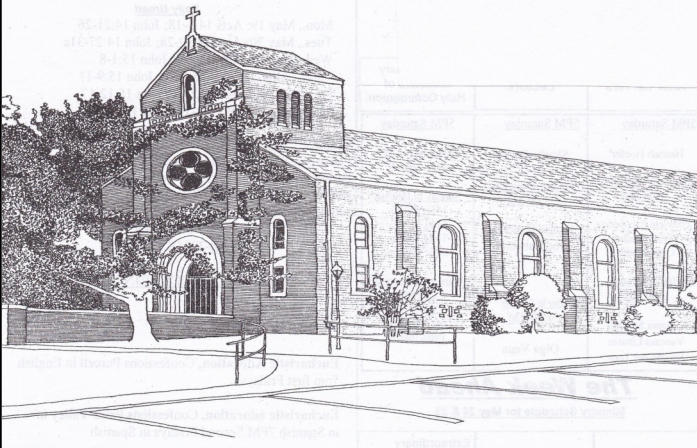

Greetings to you from Fr. John Peter

Hope you are all doing well and healthy.

October 7th is the Feast of Our Lady of Rosary and its also the Feast of Our Parish. I was dreaming of celebrating this day with the whole parish coming together and to be able to celebrate the presence and the gift of each other by way of having a parish festival or carnival. But this Pandemic does not allow us to celebrate the Feast. I will be offering a Mass at 12 noon for the whole Parish on that day which falls on Wednesday. Speaking about the parish, it is the people that make up the parish. Our parish has been in existence for the last 134 years. It is the faith and sacrifices of our predecessors that keeps the parish moving forward. Parish is a place where sacraments are celebrated, people are encouraged to participate in different ministries and serve in different capacities and reach out in service to serve the other. The children and youth are educated and formed. All these ministries are possible because of the generosity and sacrifices of so many of you. All the financial contributions that you give are used for the growth of the church and for the well-being of its members. It is you who make the church possible and I want to thank you all for your financial contributions.

Contributions to Our Lady of Victory Church General Collection/Offering are used to offset the costs associated with day-to-day operations of the parish and other programs. These costs include payroll, maintenance of buildings, utilities, and supplies, etc. Additionally, your contributions will benefit our sacramental preparation ministries, liturgical programs, and Religious Education programs. Thank you for your investment and continued support of our parish.

There are many ways to give to the Church. The most common one is our weekly offertory by which you simply place the cash or check in the offertory envelope that is given to you and place the envelope in the offertory basket during the collection at any weekend service. Be sure your check or envelope contains your name, so that donation credit may be provided for tax purposes.

Online Giving: Online giving allows for a specific dollar amount to be charged to a debit or credit card, with a small transaction fee subsidized by the Parish. Online giving is not only easy, it's also safe and secure. This option helps individuals and families remain faithful in their giving even when they are out of town or unable to attend a weekend service.

Secure online payment options are now available via Our Lady of Victory, Purcell Website. Simply click the "Online giving" tab, scroll down to and choose the payment option you prefer. You can choose to make a one-time payment or you can set up recurring payments. Although not required, should you choose to pay online, we would suggest that you create an account. Doing so will allow you to track payments, and eventually view your account details. You can go to the parish website and click "online giving" and that will lead you automatically to the link.

We ask Our Lady of Victory Parishioners to give prayerful consideration to fulfilling their weekly tithe either by using offertory envelopes, online giving, or Automatic Withdrawal (ACH). The Parish has witnessed so many generous people who are faithful to their sacrificial offering to the Church. Thank you for your willingness to share your resources with the parish.
