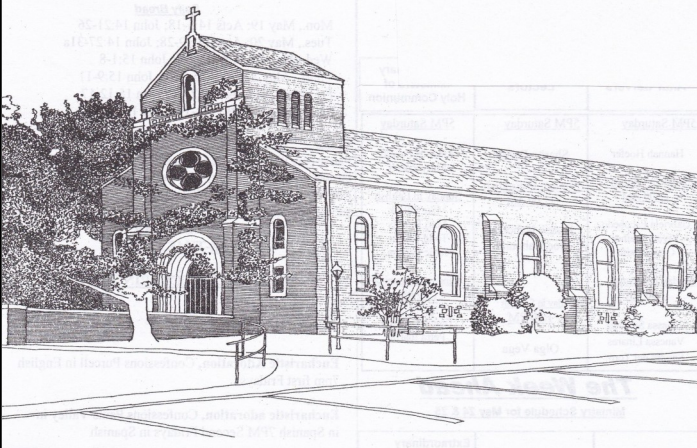

Greetings to you from Fr. John Peter

Hope you are all doing well and healthy. This week I want to update you all with regard to our Religious Education Program from Kindergarten to 8th grade, Confirmation and Post Confirmation Program. We have begun the classes for Religious Education in a serious manner. There has been a very good response with regard to the enrollment. So far, we have 90 children enrolled in the Religious Education program from kindergarten to 8th grade. Currently we have 12 children enrolled in the 2nd grade who are preparing for First Holy Communion. I want to reiterate that if there are any children who are to be enrolled for First Holy Communion Program and have not enrolled yet please parents enroll them in the RE classes. It is NOT too late. We don't want to miss any one to prepare themselves for this important sacrament in their life. This sacrament has to be given at its proper time and at its proper age and we don't want them to be delayed in receiving this sacrament. They also have to be trained so well in order to receive this sacrament. I hope that parents who have their children for First Holy Communion would pay attention to this important aspect.

We also have 18 students who are enrolled in the Confirmation and Post Confirmation Program. We have a wonderful Volunteers team of 9 who are helping in this program and the youngsters seem to be enjoying this program so well.

I wanted to update you all about this important program so that you all know how we are handling this program. I would earnestly urge every parent who has not enrolled their children in the RE Program to encourage your children to participate in the RE Programs and assist in the spiritual growth of your children. At this time, I wish to thank so many volunteers and catechists who are assisting in this program. It is because of them that this program runs so smoothly.
