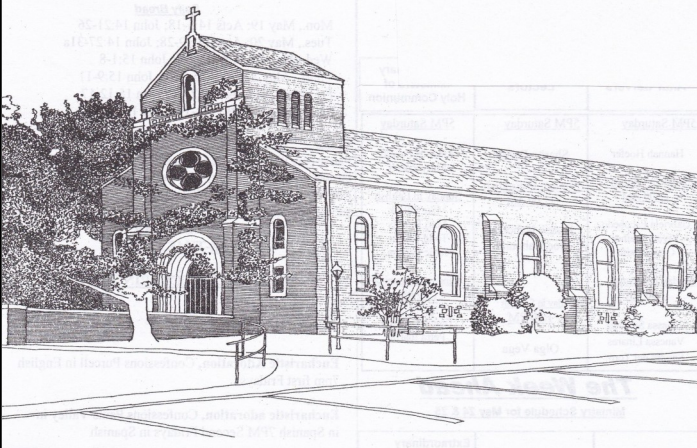

**Beatification of Fr. Michael J. McGivney, Founder of the Knights of Columbus:**

On Saturday, Oct 31, Holy Mother Church will beatify the venerable founder of the Knights of Columbus, Fr. Michael J. McGivney, at the Cathedral Church in Hartford, CT. The Mass will begin at 11 a.m. local time (10 am Oklahoma time), and be live-streamed and broadcast on both EWTN and Catholic TV. The State Council of the Knights have worked to offer "viewing" sites across the State of Oklahoma, so that Knights and their families can come together and watch this historic event as it occurs and share the joy of our venerable founder reaching the dignity of the Altar. The viewing sites are: St. John the Baptist, Edmond--St. Joseph, Norman--St. Peter, Woodward--Holy Family, Lawton--St. Bernard of Clarivaux, Tulsa. So, just to be clear, the broadcast will begin at **10:00 a.m. Oklahoma time** (central daylight). So come early. All social distancing and local safety protocols will be in place as per the parish's and local mandates require.

Further: In praise and thanksgiving to God for the Beatification of the founder of the Knights of Columbus, Blessed Michael J McGivney, the State of Oklahoma Knights of Columbus invites you to celebrate a **Mass of Thanksgiving** on Saturday November 7, 2020, **2:00 pm** at St. John the Baptist Catholic Church, 900 S. Littler Ave., Edmond, OK. His Excellency Most Reverend Paul S. Coakley Archbishop of Oklahoma City celebrant and homilist. St. John the Baptist Catholic Church as well as the Oklahoma City Archdiocese have implemented measures to address the control of the spread of the covid-19 virus. Consequently, all visitors to the parish facilities are asked to comply with the parish health safety policies in place at the time of the event. Greetings to you from Fr. John Peter  
Hope you are doing well and healthy.

We are coming close to the month of October and entering into the month of November. The days are going so fast and rapid. This week I want to write to you all about the Masses for the Souls of the Faithful Departed. **NOVEMBER, IS THE MONTH FOR THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED AND HOLY SOULS IN PURGATORY.** The month of November is traditionally dedicated by the Church to offer Masses and prayers for all the faithful departed and holy souls in purgatory so that they can be united in communion with all those gathered in Heaven. Through the communion of saints, we here on earth could "expedite" the entry into heaven of all our faithful departed brothers and sisters who are still in purgatory, purifying themselves from the temporal punishment left by their sins which were already forgiven in the Sacrament of Confession, by praying for them. As the Catechism teaches us: "Because of the communion of saints, the faithful who are still pilgrims on earth are able to help the souls in purgatory by offering PRAYERS in suffrage for them, especially the EUCHARISTIC SACRIFICE. (Catechism of the Catholic Church, n.211)

Let us have the noble desire to "EMPTY" purgatory this month of November, pleading for God's abundant mercy for our faithfully departed brothers and sisters in need. Our Lady of Victory, intercede and pray for our suffering children in Purgatory so that they may quickly be purified and enter into the heavenly vision of the Most Blessed Trinity as soon as possible!

I am positive that you must have the envelop for the All Souls Offertory in your packet of Sunday Offering Envelops. You may use them to offer the Masses for the departed souls of your loved ones.

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. And may the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.

**HEALING MASS AT OUR LADY OF VICTORY CHURCH**

**Tuesday, November 10<sup>th</sup>, 7:00 p.m.**

Are there any who are sick among you? Let them send for the priests of the Church and let them pray over them, anointing them with the oil in the name of the Lord; and the prayer of the faithful will save the sick man, and Lord will raise them up; and if they have committed any sins, their sins will be forgiven. The Church receives the gift of healing power from the Lord as one of a list of charisms listed in the Letter of James. Anointing of the Sick is intended to bring about spiritual and even physical effects for those sick persons who approach in faith. Any person who is seriously ill, weakened by old age (even if no serious illness is present), or preparing for serious surgery due to illness may receive the sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Each of us are in need of Physical, Spiritual, Mental, Emotional, Psychological healing. And those who are in need of healing of Mind and Body can approach this Sacrament. On that day there won't be morning Mass but instead we will have the evening Mass in the Church so that many people can take part in the Sacrament of Healing. Come and get healed.
