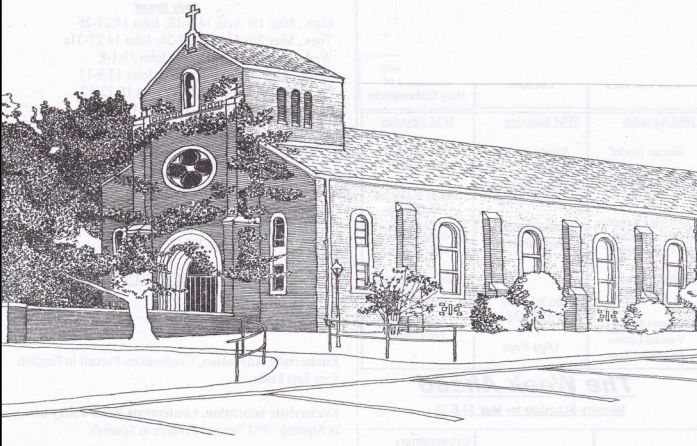

**HEALING MASS AT OUR LADY OF VICTORY
CHURCH**

Tuesday, November 10th, 7:00 p.m.

Are there any who are sick among you? Let them send for the priests of the Church and let them pray over them, anointing them with the oil in the name of the Lord; and the prayer of the faithful will save the sick man, and Lord will raise them up; and if they have committed any sins, their sins will be forgiven. The Church receives the gift of healing power from the Lord as one of a list of charisms listed in the Letter of James. Anointing of the Sick is intended to bring about spiritual and even physical effects for those sick persons who approach in faith. Any person who is seriously ill, weakened by old age (even if no serious illness is present), or preparing for serious surgery due to illness may receive the sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Each of us are in need of Physical, Spiritual, Mental, Emotional, Psychological healing. And those who are in need of healing of Mind and Body can approach this Sacrament. On that day there won't be morning Mass but instead we will have the evening Mass in the Church so that many people can take part in the Sacrament of Healing. Come and get healed.

¿Hay alguno que esté enfermo entre ustedes? Cualquier persona que esté gravemente enferma, debilitada por la vejez (incluso si no hay una enfermedad grave) o que se esté preparándose para una cirugía grave debido a una enfermedad puede recibir el sacramento de la Unción de los Enfermos. Cada uno de nosotros está en necesidad de sanación física, espiritual, mental, emocional y psicológica. Y aquellos que necesiten sanación de Mente y Cuerpo pueden acercarse a este Sacramento. Este día no habrá Misa de la mañana, sino que tendremos la Misa de la tarde en la Iglesia para que muchas personas puedan participar en el Sacramento de Sanación. Ven y queda sano.
