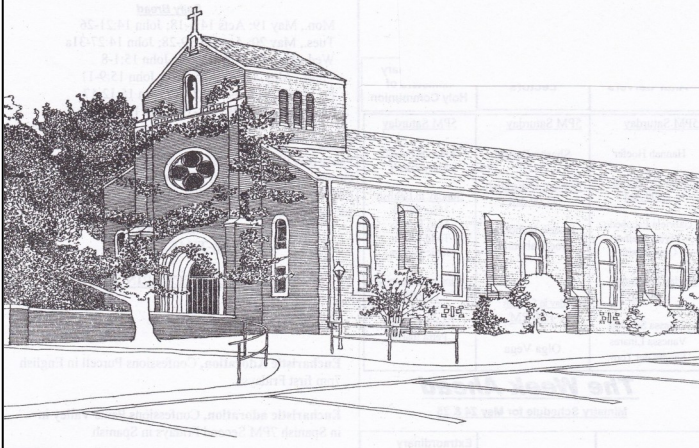

Dear Parishioners,
Greetings to you from Fr. John Peter.

Hope that you are all doing well. I hope that you have a good Thanksgiving Celebrations. Able to appreciate and celebrate the presence of each other during this time of gratitude. It is quite alarming with the increase in the number of Covid cases. There have been some of the parishioners who have attended the Spanish Masses that have tested positive. Some of them are in quarantine. I feel bad with the situation as it affects the mass attendance and disrupts the lives of people. I keep on praying that we may find a solution very soon.

Next week is the Solemnity of Jesus Christ the King of the Universe and it brings to conclusion the liturgical year as this Solemnity is combined with the 34th Sunday of the Ordinary time. With that the Liturgical Year that we began last November comes to an end. It is so meaningful to end the liturgical year with the Solemnity of Christ the King. This feast came into existence when the world was in turmoil and the increasing growth of secularism was spreading throughout the world, Pope Pius XI sought to combat it with an affirmation that Jesus Christ is the true king to whom we owe allegiance. The last Sunday of November seemed the most convenient of all for this purpose, because it is at the end of the liturgical year, and thus the feast of the Kingship of Christ sets the crowning glory upon the mysteries of the life of Christ already commemorated during the year, and, before celebrating the triumph of all the Saints, we proclaim and extol the glory of him who triumphs in all the Saints and in all the Elect.

We participate in that kingship when we serve others and order our lives according to the Gospel. The saints in Heaven were successful in that regard and were true servants of the King, pouring out his love to all those in the world. While this feast was later moved to the end of November to heighten its connection to the end of the liturgical year, this spiritual theme still retains its power and reminds us what it means to be obedient servants of a benevolent King. We will inherit the joys of the Kingdom only when we recognize our role as faithful servants, ready and willing to do whatever it takes to bring about a reign of love that covers the whole world.

May this Solemnity of Jesus Christ King of the Universe, remind us always that we belong to the Kingdom of God and die as his loyal servants. As the words of St. Thomas More: "I die the King's good servant and God's First".

Thanks for all that you do for the Church. May God bless your generosity to the Church.

La próxima semana es la Solemnidad de Jesucristo Rey del Universo y concluye el año litúrgico ya que esta Solemnidad se combina con el 34° Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario. Con eso llega a su fin el Año Litúrgico que iniciamos el pasado mes de noviembre. Es muy significativo terminar el año litúrgico con la solemnidad de Cristo Rey. Esta fiesta nació cuando el mundo estaba en crisis y el creciente crecimiento del secularismo se extendía por todo el mundo, el Papa Pío XI trató de combatirlo con la afirmación de que Jesucristo es el verdadero rey a quien debemos lealtad. El último domingo de noviembre parecía el más conveniente de todos para este propósito, porque es al final del año litúrgico, y así la fiesta de la realeza de Cristo pone la gloria suprema sobre los misterios de la vida de Cristo ya conmemorados durante el año y, antes de celebrar el triunfo de todos los santos, proclamamos y ensalzamos la gloria de aquel que triunfa en todos los santos y en todos los elegidos.
