Dear Parishioners,

Greetings to you from Fr. John Peter Swaminathan. Hope you are all doing well. I hope that many of you were able to get the vaccines that are available so that you all can get back to the Church just in time for Easter. I would love to see you all in the Church very soon.

Last Friday, March 19<sup>th</sup> the Church celebrated the Solemnity of St. Joseph. St. Joseph is known as the Foster Father of Jesus Christ. He was a just man and not much is said about him but that he was faithful to the plan of God revealed to him in his dreams by the Angel. Pope Francis announced a Year of St. Joseph beginning from 8<sup>th</sup> of December 2020 to 8<sup>th</sup> of December 2021. In establishing the year, he said that "every member of the faithful, following his example, may strengthen their life of faith daily in the complete fulfillment of God's will."

The Church observes the passage of time through the liturgical calendar - which includes feasts such as Easter and Christmas, and seasons such as Lent and Advent. In addition, however, popes can set aside time for the Church to reflect more deeply on a specific aspect of Catholic teaching or belief. Past years designated by recent popes include a Year of Faith, Year of the Eucharist, and Jubilee Year of Mercy.

Pope Francis said the coronavirus pandemic has heightened his desire to reflect on St. Joseph, as so many people during the pandemic have made hidden sacrifices to protect others, just as St. Joseph quietly protected and cared for Mary and Jesus. "Each of us can discover in Joseph -- the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence -- an intercessor, a support and a guide in times of trouble," the pope wrote. He also said he wanted to highlight St. Joseph's role as a father who served his family with charity and humility, adding, "Our world today needs fathers."

As Catholics pray and reflect on the life of St. Joseph throughout the coming year, they also have opportunities to gain a plenary indulgence, or remission of all temporal punishment due to sin. An indulgence can be applied to oneself or to a soul in Purgatory. An indulgence requires a specific act, defined by the Church, as well as sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion, prayer for the pope's intentions, and full detachment from sin. Special indulgences during the Year of St. Joseph can be received by praying for the unemployed, entrusting one's daily work to St. Joseph, performing a corporal or spiritual work of mercy.

Catholics do not worship saints but ask for their heavenly intercession before God and seek to imitate their virtues here on earth. The Catholic Church honors St. Joseph as the foster father of Jesus. He is invoked as the patron saint of the Universal Church. He is also the patron of workers, father, and a happy death.

Thank You for all that you do to the Church.

Estimados feligreses,

Saludos de parte del P. John Peter Swaminathan. Espero que estén bien. Espero que muchos de ustedes hayan podido obtener las vacunas disponibles para que puedan regresar a la Iglesia justo a tiempo para la Pascua. Me encantaría verlos a todos en la Iglesia muy pronto.

El pasado viernes 19 de marzo la Iglesia celebró la Solemnidad de San José. San José es conocido como el padre adoptivo de Jesucristo. Era un hombre justo y no se dice mucho de él, pero que fue fiel al plan de Dios que le reveló en sus sueños el ángel. El Papa Francisco anunció un Año a San José a partir del 8 de diciembre de 2020 al 8 de diciembre de 2021. Al establecer el año, dijo que "cada miembro de los fieles, siguiendo su ejemplo, puede fortalecer su vida de fe diariamente en la completa cumplimiento de la voluntad de Dios".

La Iglesia observa el paso del tiempo a través del calendario litúrgico, que incluye fiestas como Pascua y Navidad, y temporadas como Cuaresma y Adviento. Además, sin embargo, los papas pueden reservar tiempo para que la Iglesia reflexione más profundamente sobre un aspecto específico de la enseñanza o creencia católica. Los años pasados designados por papas recientes incluyen un Año de la Fe, el Año de la Eucaristía y el Año del Jubileo de la Misericordia.

El Papa Francisco dijo que la pandemia de coronavirus ha aumentado su deseo de reflexionar sobre San José, ya que muchas personas durante la pandemia han hecho sacrificios ocultos para proteger a otros, al igual que San José protegió y cuidó en silencio a María y a Jesús. "Cada uno de nosotros puede descubrir en San José, el hombre que pasa desapercibido, una presencia diaria, discreta y oculta, un intercesor, un apoyo y un guía en tiempos de angustia", escribió el Papa. También dijo que quería resaltar el papel de San José como un padre que sirvió a su familia con caridad y humildad, y agregó: "Nuestro mundo de hoy necesita padres".

Mientras los católicos oran y reflexionan sobre la vida de San José durante el próximo año, también tienen la oportunidad de obtener una indulgencia plenaria o la remisión de todo castigo temporal debido al pecado. Una indulgencia se puede aplicar a uno mismo o a un alma en el Purgatorio. Una indulgencia requiere un acto específico, definido por la Iglesia, así como la confesión sacramental, la Comunión Eucarística, la oración por las intenciones del Papa y el desprendimiento total del pecado.

Se pueden recibir indulgencias especiales durante el Año de San José rezando por los desempleados, confiando el trabajo diario a San José, realizando una obra de misericordia corporal o espiritual. Los católicos no adoran a los santos, pero piden su intercesión celestial ante Dios y buscan imitar sus virtudes aquí en la tierra. La Iglesia Católica honra a San José como el padre adoptivo de Jesús. Se le invoca como el santo patrón de la Iglesia Universal. También es el patrón de los trabajadores, de los padres y el ayudante para una muerte feliz.

Gracias por todo lo que le hace a la Iglesia.
