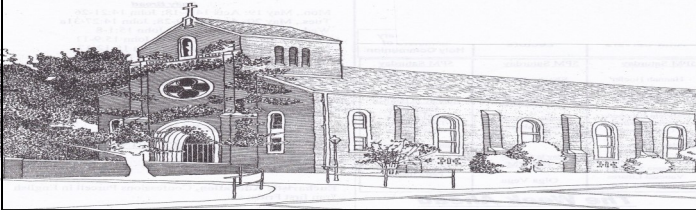

Palm Sunday March 27th & 28th 2021: All the Palm Sunday Liturgies will begin with the Procession from the Statue of the Blessed Mother Located outside the Church on the East Side.

Holy Thursday April 1st 2021: Services on Holy Thursday will be held at 7:00 pm during which we will have the washing of the feet of youth who will be receiving their Confirmation this year. We will be having a Special Offertory during which you can bring all your savings by way of rice bowls collection. At the end of the Mass there will be the Eucharistic Procession in the church and transfer the Blessed Sacrament to the Altar adjacent to the Infant Jesus Statue where we will have adoration till 10 pm. All are most welcome to participate in the Eucharistic Procession and Adoration. Please sign up for the Eucharist Adoration till 10 pm.

Good Friday Schedule April 2nd 2021: 2:30 pm Stations of the Cross in Spanish. 7:00 pm Stations of the Cross in English and Liturgy of the Veneration of the Cross.

Easter Vigil April 3rd 2021: Easter Vigil at 8:30 pm during which we will be welcoming the 1 catechumen and 2 candidates into the church by administering the required Sacraments.

Easter Sunday April 4th 2021: Easter Sunday Mass in English at 11 am and Spanish Mass at 1 pm.

Dear Parishioners,

Greetings to you from Fr. John Peter Swaminathan. Hope you are all doing well. Here we are already at the beginning of Holy Week. We just began the season of Lent and already we have arrived at the Holy Week. Where is the time flying?

Palm Sunday is the final Sunday of Lent, the beginning of Holy Week, and commemorates the triumphant arrival of Christ in Jerusalem, days before he was crucified. Palm Sunday is known as such because the faithful will often receive palms which they use to participate in the reenactment of Christ's arrival in Jerusalem. In the Gospels, Jesus entered Jerusalem riding a young donkey, and to the lavish praise of the townspeople who threw clothes, or possibly palms or small branches, in front of him as a sign of homage. This was a customary practice for people of great respect.

Palm branches are widely recognized symbol of peace and victory, hence their preferred use on Palm Sunday. The use of a donkey instead of a horse is highly symbolic, it represents the humble arrival of someone in peace, as opposed to arriving on a steed in war.

Palm Sunday speaks of the disparity and fickle mindedness of the people. It is a time of despair, perplexity and contradiction. The very people who applaud Christ's entrance into Jerusalem that morning, shouting out "Hosanna" and words of adoration will, within a week, be crying, "Crucify Him." They will go from acclaiming Him as the new King of Israel to urging His life be traded in favor of a convicted criminal; they will first praise Him and then mock Him. Even friends entering Jerusalem at His side will desert Jesus. All this discord will take place during one week beginning on what we call Palm Sunday.

It is a beautiful time for us Catholics to return back to the Church and to participate in the Holy Week Services which are so meaningful and uplifting for us. It is good to Share in the sorrow of Jesus so as to participate in the Joy of his Resurrection.

Thank You for all that you do to the Church.

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Estimados feligreses,

Saludos de parte del P. John Peter Swaminathan. Espero que estén bien. Aquí ya estamos al inicio de la Semana Santa. Recién comenzamos el tiempo de Cuaresma y ya hemos llegado a la Semana Santa. ¿Hacia dónde está volando el tiempo?

El Domingo de Ramos es el último domingo de Cuaresma, el comienzo de la Semana Santa, y conmemora la llegada triunfal de Cristo a Jerusalén, días antes de ser crucificado. El Domingo de Ramos se conoce como tal porque los fieles a menudo reciben palmas que utilizan para participar en la recreación de la llegada de Cristo a Jerusalén. En los Evangelios, Jesús entró en Jerusalén montado en un burro, y ante la fastuosa alabanza de la gente del pueblo, que arrojaron pañuelos, o posiblemente palmas o ramitas, frente a él como señal de homenaje. Esta era una práctica habitual para las personas de gran respeto.

Las ramas de palma son un símbolo ampliamente reconocido de paz y victoria, de ahí su uso preferido el Domingo de Ramos. El uso de un burro en lugar de un caballo es altamente simbólico, representa la humilde llegada de alguien en paz, en contraposición a la llegada de un corcel en la guerra.

El Domingo de Ramos habla de la disparidad y la volubilidad de la gente. Es una época de desesperación, perplejidad y contradicción. Las mismas personas que aplauden la entrada de Cristo en Jerusalén esa mañana, gritando "Hosanna" y palabras de adoración, dentro de una semana, estarán gritando: "Crucificalo". Pasarán de aclamarlo como el nuevo Rey de Israel a instar a que Su vida se cambie a favor de un criminal convicto; primero lo alabarán y luego se burlarán de él. Incluso los amigos que entren a Jerusalén a su lado abandonarán a Jesús. Toda esta discordia se producirá durante una semana a partir de lo que llamamos Domingo de Ramos.

Es un momento hermoso para que los católicos regresemos a la Iglesia y participemos en los servicios de Semana Santa, que son tan significativos y edificantes para nosotros. Es bueno compartir el dolor de Jesús para participar de la alegría de su resurrección.

Gracias por todo lo que le hace a la Iglesia.
