Dear Parishioners,

Greetings to you from Fr. John Peter Swaminathan. Hope you are all doing well. Wish you all a Happy and Joyous Easter.

The Second Sunday of Easter is normally known as Divine Mercy Sunday. In the 1930's, the Lord Jesus, in a series of private revelations, appeared to a Polish nun, Sister Maria Faustina Kowalska. He told her that he wanted her to write down what he told her about His message of Mercy and that she would be the "apostle and secretary" of His Mercy. Sr. Faustina was eventually beatified by Pope John Paul in 1983 and canonized by him in the year 2000. In his homily at the Mass of St. Faustina's canonization, Pope John Paul declared the Second Sunday of Easter would now be celebrated as Divine Mercy Sunday throughout the Universal Church.

The Divine Mercy Chaplet (Normally prayed with rosary beads.)

Begin with the Sign of the Cross First three prayers – Our Father, Hail Mary, Apostles Creed On each of the "Our Father" beads of the Rosary, the following prayer is said: Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity, of your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

On each of the Hail Mary beads of the Rosary, the following prayer is said: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world. At the end of the Chaplet, say three times: Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world. End with the Sign of the Cross.

Sister Faustina records in her diary entitled Divine Mercy in My Soul that the Lord Jesus spoke these words to her regarding the chaplet: Say unceasingly the chaplet that I have taught you. Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death. Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation. Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy. I desire to grant unimaginable graces to those souls who trust in My Mercy. (687)

A plenary indulgence is available to those who observe Divine Mercy Sunday following the usual prescriptions – Sacramental Confession, reception of Holy Communion, free from all attachment to sin. Therefore, we will have an hour of adoration on 11<sup>th</sup> of April Sunday, from 3 pm to 4 pm in the Church with the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Confessions followed by the recitation of the Divine Mercy Chaplet. Please come participate and obtain the infinite mercy of God.

Thank You for all that you do to the Church.

Estimados feligreses,

Saludos de parte del P. John Peter Swaminathan. Espero que estén bien. Les deseo a todos una Feliz Pascua.

El Segundo Domingo de Pascua se conoce normalmente como Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. En la década de 1930, el Señor Jesús, en una serie de revelaciones privadas, se apareció a una monja polaca, la hermana María Faustina Kowalska. Él le dijo que quería que ella escribiera lo que le dijo acerca de Su mensaje de Misericordia y que ella sería la "apóstol y secretaria" de Su Misericordia. Sor Faustina fue finalmente beatificada por el Papa Juan Pablo en 1983 y canonizada por él en el año 2000. En su homilía en la Misa de canonización de Santa Faustina, el Papa Juan Pablo declaró que el Segundo Domingo de Pascua ahora se celebraría como Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, en toda la Iglesia Universal.

La Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia (normalmente rezada con un rosario).

Comience con la Señal de la Cruz Las primeras tres oraciones: Padre Nuestro, Ave María, Credo de los Apóstoles En cada una de las cuentas del Rosario del "Padre Nuestro", se dice la siguiente oración: Padre Eterno, te ofrezco el Cuerpo y la Sangre, Alma y la Divinidad, de tu amado Hijo, Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, en expiación por nuestros pecados y los del mundo entero.

En cada una de las cuentas del Ave María del Rosario, se dice la siguiente oración: Por Su dolorosa Pasión, ten misericordia de nosotros y del mundo entero. Al final de la Coronilla, se dice tres veces: Santo Dios, Santo Fuerte, Santo Inmortal, ten misericordia de nosotros y del mundo entero. Termina con la Señal de la Cruz.

Sor Faustina registra en su diario titulado Divina Misericordia en Mi Alma que el Señor Jesús le dijo estas palabras sobre la coronilla: Di sin cesar la coronilla que te he enseñado. Quien lo recite recibirá gran misericordia a la hora de la muerte. Los sacerdotes lo recomendarán a los pecadores como su última esperanza de salvación. Incluso si hubiera un pecador más endurecido, si recitara esta coronilla solo una vez, recibiría la gracia de Mi infinita misericordia. Deseo conceder gracias inimaginables a aquellas almas que confían en Mi Misericordia. (687)

Una indulgencia plenaria está disponible para aquellos que observan el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia siguiendo las prescripciones habituales: Confesión Sacramental, recepción de la Sagrada Comunión, libre de todo apego al pecado. Por lo tanto, tendremos una hora de adoración el domingo 11 de abril, de 3 pm a 4 pm en la Iglesia con la exposición del Santísimo Sacramento, Confesiones seguidas del rezo de la Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia. Ven a participar y obtén la infinita misericordia de Dios.

Gracias por todo lo que le hace a la Iglesia.
