Dear Parishioners,

Greetings to you from Fr. John Peter Swaminathan. Hope you are all doing well. I am sure that all of us had a good celebration of Easter. Now is the time of First Holy Communion. This year we have 13 children receiving their First Holy Communion. This is something special for them in their lives.

Through the grace of the sacrament of marriage, parents receive the responsibility and privilege of evangelizing their children. Parents should initiate their children at an early age into the mysteries of the faith of which they are the "first heralds" for their children.

“Train the young in the way they should go; even when old, they will not swerve from it.” Proverbs 22:6 A child's First Holy Communion marks the beginning of their sacramental life in the Catholic Church. Your children will be embarking on their lifelong sacramental journey with Christ and the Church as they begin their age of reasoning. They will begin to develop a deeper understanding of what it means to live a sanctified life with Christ and what role God has for them in the Church. This is the greatest opportunity for parents to expand their role as teachers and nurturers of their children both by example and guidance. As parents, you are the primary catechists of your children and our religious education programs are designed to support your efforts.

The First Holy Communion is an important and special day for kids, their families, and the Church. The First Communion is a celebration of children becoming part of the Catholic church. During a child's First Communion, it is important to remind them what the point of it is, why they should know how special it is, and make sure they understand the significance in this moment. This is also a great time for parents to reconnect with their faith. It is also important that they understand why their First Communion is so special because of what they have learned at Mass and religious schooling, they should already realize the significance in this day.

I would invite you all that we create space for the families of the First Holy Communion Children to attend the Mass on Saturday, April 17th at 5 pm Mass so that there is enough room in the Church. The rest of the families can attend the Mass on Sunday April 18th.
