Dear Parishioners,

Greetings to you from Fr. John Peter Swaminathan. Tuesday, May 11<sup>th</sup>, our Archbishop was here to confer the Sacrament of Confirmation on 18 youth of our Parish. It was an important day in the lives of these youngsters as they received the Holy Spirit that all of us have received when we were confirmed. This Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost which is the birthday of the Church. Pentecost marks the end of the Easter season and points to the beginning of a new stage in the Church's annual cycle Pentecost is one of the few holidays in the liturgical year to have an eight-day celebration, known as an octave. The others are Christmas, and Easter.

On Pentecost, the Church celebrates the descent of the Holy Spirit. Pentecost takes place on the fiftieth day after Easter. In Acts we read about the astonishing scene: the disciples were gathered for the feast of Pentecost when, suddenly, a great sound like a rushing wind blew through the room and tongues of fire appeared and rested on their heads. All those assembled then began speaking in many languages, proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ. A crowd gathered because of the great commotion and supposed them to be drunk, but Peter stood up and preached to them, opening up the scripture to them concerning Jesus, the Christ, the Son of God, and the one whom they had crucified. The people were cut to the heart and asked what they should do. And Peter said to them, "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. Many believed and were baptized that day. And to this day, generation after generation, thousands more are added through Holy Baptism and receive the Holy Spirit.

If you are not coming to the Church, it is time for you all to get back to the Church to fulfill your Sunday Obligation. Please consider joining other members of the Church to worship together. Thank You for all that you do to the Church.

Saludos de parte del P. John Peter Swaminathan. El martes pasado 11 de mayo, nuestro Arzobispo estuvo aquí para conferir el Sacramento de la Confirmación a 18 jóvenes de nuestra Parroquia. Fue un día importante en la vida de estos jóvenes ya que recibieron el Espíritu Santo que todos nosotros hemos recibido cuando fuimos confirmados. Y este domingo celebramos la solemnidad de Pentecostés que es el cumpleaños de la Iglesia. Pentecostés marca el final de la temporada de Pascua y apunta al comienzo de una nueva etapa en el ciclo anual de la Iglesia. Pentecostés es una de las pocas fiestas en el año litúrgico que tiene una celebración de ocho días, conocida como octava. Los otros son Navidad y Semana Santa.

En Pentecostés, la Iglesia celebra la venida del Espíritu Santo. Pentecostés tiene lugar el quincuagésimo día después de Pascua. En Hechos leemos acerca de la asombrosa escena: los discípulos estaban reunidos para la fiesta de Pentecostés cuando, de repente, un gran sonido como un viento recio sopló por la habitación y aparecieron lenguas de fuego que se posaron sobre sus cabezas. Todos los reunidos comenzaron a hablar en muchos idiomas, proclamando el Evangelio de Jesucristo. A causa de la gran conmoción se reunió una multitud que creía que estaban borrachos, pero Pedro se puso de pie y les predicó, abriéndoles la Escritura acerca de Jesús, el Cristo, el Hijo de Dios, y el que habían crucificado. Los corazones de la gente fueron tocados y comenzaron a preguntar qué debían hacer. Y Pedro les dijo: "Arrepiéntanse y bautícese cada uno de ustedes en el nombre de Jesucristo para el perdón de sus pecados, y recibirán el don del Espíritu Santo. Muchos creyeron y fueron bautizados ese día. Y hasta el día de hoy, generación tras generación, miles más se agregan a través del Santo Bautismo y reciben el Espíritu Santo.
