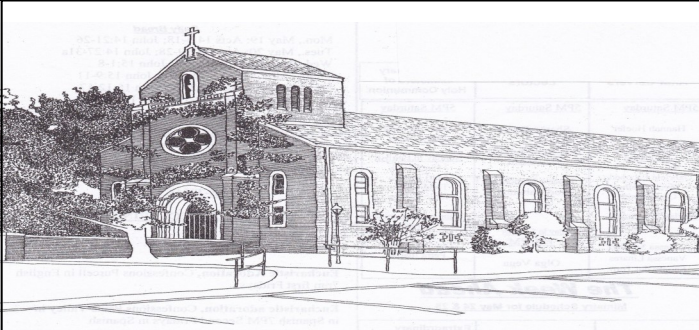




May 29th & 30th
