Dear Parishioners,

Greetings to you all from Fr. John Peter. Hope you are doing well.

The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is an important feast for us Catholics. The Sacred Heart of Jesus represents Jesus' divine love for humanity. The Feast of the Sacred Heart is celebrated 19 days after Pentecost. As Pentecost is always celebrated on Sunday, the Feast of the Sacred Heart always falls on a Friday. Jesus Christ appeared to Margaret Mary Alacoque in the 17th century and one of the blessings which he promised to those who practice devotion to his Sacred Heart:

“In the excess of the mercy of my Heart, I promise you that my all powerful love will grant to all those who will receive Communion on the First Fridays, for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance: they will not die in my displeasure, nor without receiving the sacraments; and my Heart will be their secure refuge in that last hour.”

This promise led to the Roman Catholics, the practice of attending Mass and receiving Holy Communion on the first Friday of each month. First Friday of every month is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Attending Mass on the First Friday of the month and receiving the communion was popular among many Catholics, even if they are unable to attend daily Mass regularly throughout the week. This is because, as each Sunday is a reminder and anniversary of Christ's Resurrection, each Friday is a reminder and anniversary of His Sacrifice. On every First Friday of the Month we have Mass in the morning at 9 am and one hour of adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and time to go for reconciliation in the evening at 7 pm. You are most welcome to come and participate in the adoration.

If you are not coming to the Church due to Covid, it's time to get back to the Church as the Sunday Mass is an obligation now. I would like to welcome you back to the Church for the Sunday Mass.

Estimados feligreses,

Saludos a todos ustedes de parte del P. Juan Pedro. Espero que estés bien.

La Solemnidad del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús es una fiesta importante para nosotros los católicos. El Sagrado Corazón de Jesús representa el amor divino de Jesús por la humanidad. La Fiesta del Sagrado Corazón se celebra 19 días después de Pentecostés. Como Pentecostés siempre se celebra en domingo, la fiesta del Sagrado Corazón siempre cae en viernes. Jesucristo se apareció a Margarita María Alacoque en el siglo XVII y una de las bendiciones que prometió a quienes practican la devoción a su Sagrado Corazón:

“En el exceso de la misericordia de mi Corazón, les prometo que mi amor todopoderoso concederá a todos aquellos que comulguen los primeros viernes, durante nueve meses consecutivos, la gracia del arrepentimiento final: no morirán en mi disgusto, ni sin recibir los sacramentos; y mi Corazón será su refugio seguro en esa última hora ”.

Esta promesa llevó a los católicos romanos a la práctica de asistir a Misa y recibir la Sagrada Comunión el primer viernes de cada mes. El primer viernes de cada mes está dedicado al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús. Asistir a misa el primer viernes de cada mes y recibir la comunión era algo popular entre muchos católicos, incluso si no podían asistir a la misa diaria con regularidad durante la semana. Esto se debe a que, como cada domingo es un recordatorio y un aniversario de la resurrección de Cristo, cada viernes es un recordatorio y un aniversario de su sacrificio. Cada primer viernes del mes tenemos Misa por la mañana a las 9 am y una hora de adoración al Santísimo Sacramento y tiempo para ir a la reconciliación por la tarde a las 7 pm. Le invitamos a venir y participar en la adoración.

Si no viene a la Iglesia debido a Covid, es hora de volver a la Iglesia ya que la misa dominical es una obligación ahora. Me gustaría darle la bienvenida a la Iglesia para la misa dominical.
