Dear Parishioners,

Greetings to you from Fr. John Peter Swaminathan. **On June 29 the Church celebrates the feast day of Sts. Peter & Paul. Together, the two saints are the founders of the See of Rome, through their preaching, ministry, and martyrdom there.**

Peter, who was named Simon, was a fisherman of Galilee and was introduced to the Lord Jesus by his brother Andrew, also a fisherman. Jesus gave him the name Cephas (Petrus in Latin), which means 'Rock,' because he was to become the rock upon which Christ would build His Church. Peter was a bold follower of the Lord. He was the first to recognize that Jesus was "the Messiah, the Son of the living God," and eagerly pledged his fidelity until death. In his boldness, he also made many mistakes, however, such as losing faith when walking on water with Christ and betraying the Lord on the night of His passion. Yet despite his human weaknesses, Peter was chosen to shepherd God's flock. The Acts of the Apostles illustrates his role as head of the Church after the Resurrection and Ascension of Christ. Peter led the Apostles as the first Pope and ensured that the disciples kept the true faith. St. Peter spent his last years in Rome, leading the Church through persecution and eventually being martyred in the year 64. He was crucified upside-down at his own request because he claimed he was not worthy to die as his Lord. He was buried on Vatican hill, and St. Peter's Basilica is built over his tomb.

St. Paul was the Apostle of the Gentiles. His letters are included in the writings of the New Testament, and through them we learn much about his life and the faith of the early Church. Before receiving the name Paul, he was Saul, a Jewish pharisee who zealously persecuted Christians in Jerusalem. Saul's conversion took place as he was on his way to Damascus to persecute the Christian community there. As he was traveling along the road, he was suddenly surrounded by a great light from heaven. He was blinded and fell off his horse. He then heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute me?" He answered: "Who are you, Lord?" Christ said: "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting." Saul continued to Damascus, where he was baptized, and his sight was restored. He took the name Paul and spent the remainder of his life preaching the Gospel tirelessly to the Gentiles of the Mediterranean world. Paul was imprisoned and taken to Rome, where he was beheaded in the year 67. He is buried in Rome in the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls.

May the intercessions of Sts. Peter and Paul help us to continue our journey here on earth in building up the Kingdom of God and be firm to our faith.

Please consider joining other members of the Church to worship together. Thank You for all that you do to the Church.

Estimados feligreses,

**Saludos de parte del P. John Peter Swaminathan. El 29 de junio la Iglesia celebra la fiesta de los Santos. Peter y Paul. Juntos, los dos santos son los fundadores de la Sede de Roma, a través de su predicación, ministerio y martirio allí.**

Pedro, que se llamaba Simón, era pescador de Galilea y fue presentado al Señor Jesús por su hermano Andrés, también pescador. Jesús le dio el nombre de Cefas (Petrus en latín), que significa "Roca", porque él se convertiría en la roca sobre la cual Cristo edificaría Su Iglesia. Pedro fue un seguidor valiente del Señor. Fue el primero en reconocer que Jesús era "el Mesías, el Hijo del Dios viviente" y prometió con entusiasmo su fidelidad hasta la muerte. Sin embargo, en su osadía también cometió muchos errores, como perder la fe al caminar sobre las aguas con Cristo y traicionar al Señor en la noche de su pasión. Sin embargo, a pesar de sus debilidades humanas, Pedro fue elegido para pastorear el rebaño de Dios. Los Hechos de los Apóstoles ilustran su papel como cabeza de la Iglesia después de la Resurrección y Ascensión de Cristo. Pedro dirigió a los Apóstoles como el primer Papa y se aseguró de que los discípulos mantuvieran la verdadera fe. San Pedro pasó sus últimos años en Roma, guiando a la Iglesia a través de la persecución y finalmente fue martirizado en el año 64. Fue crucificado boca abajo a pedido suyo porque afirmó que no era digno de morir como su Señor. Fue enterrado en la colina del Vaticano y la Basílica de San Pedro está construida sobre su tumba.

San Pablo fue el apóstol de los gentiles. Sus cartas están incluidas en los escritos del Nuevo Testamento y, a través de ellas, aprendemos mucho sobre su vida y la fe de la Iglesia primitiva. Antes de recibir el nombre de Pablo, era Saulo, un fariseo judío que perseguía con celo a los cristianos en Jerusalén. La conversión de Saulo tuvo lugar cuando se dirigía a Damasco para perseguir a la comunidad cristiana allí. Mientras viajaba por el camino, de repente se vio rodeado por una gran luz del cielo. Quedó cegado y se cayó de su caballo. Entonces escuchó una voz que le decía: "Saulo, Saulo, ¿por qué me persigues?" Él respondió: "¿Quién eres, Señor?" Cristo dijo: "Yo soy Jesús, a quien tú persigues". Saulo continuó hasta Damasco, donde fue bautizado y recuperó la vista. Tomó el nombre de Pablo y pasó el resto de su vida predicando incansablemente el Evangelio a los gentiles del mundo mediterráneo. Pablo fue encarcelado y llevado a Roma, donde fue decapitado en el año 67. Está enterrado en Roma en la Basílica de San Pablo Extramuros.

Que las intercesiones de los Santos. Pedro y Pablo nos ayudan a continuar nuestro viaje aquí en la tierra para edificar el Reino de Dios y ser firmes en nuestra fe.

Considere unirse a otros miembros de la Iglesia para adorar juntos. Gracias por todo lo que le hace a la Iglesia.
