Dear Parishioners,

Greetings to you from Fr. John Peter Swaminathan. Hope you are all doing well.

On September 8<sup>th</sup> we celebrate the birthday of our Blessed Mother. We all know that everyone has a birthday. The Bible doesn't say anything about Mary's birth, but we know that she was born. Like all parents, Mary's parents were Joachim and Ann and took their daughter as special. Joachim and Ann loved God very much, and they were filled with gratitude to God for the gift of a child. They raised Mary as a child of God, teaching her to love and serve God. When the angel Gabriel told Mary that she was chosen to be the mother of Jesus, she already had great faith in God. Her strong faith and trust allowed her to say yes to God's plan for her. We cannot be certain what the future holds for any newborn infant, but we do know that the life of each person has meaning and purpose. When Mary was born, the world did not know who she was but now everyone knows that she is the mother of Jesus. Today thank God for the gift of life, and give honor to both Mary and Jesus by showing respect and concern for one another, remembering that God has created each person with love and with a call to something very special in life.

The feasts of saints are traditionally celebrated on the day of their death, because that is the date on which they entered into eternal life. And, indeed, we also celebrate the Blessed Virgin Mary's entrance into Heaven on August 15, the Feast of the Assumption.

There are only three people whose birthdays have traditionally been celebrated by Christians. Jesus Christ, at Christmas; Saint John the Baptist; and the Blessed Virgin Mary. And we celebrate all three birthdays for the same reason: all three were born without Original Sin. Christ, because He was conceived by the Holy Spirit. Mary kept free from the stain of Original Sin by the action of God in His foreknowledge that she would agree to be the mother of Christ; and Saint John, because he was blessed in the womb by the presence of his Savior when Mary, pregnant with Jesus, came to aid her cousin Elizabeth in the final months of Elizabeth's pregnancy (an event we celebrate in the Feast of the Visitation).

Thank You once again for all that you do for the Parish.

Estimados feligreses,

Saludos de parte del P. John Peter Swaminathan. Espero que estén todos bien.

El 8 de septiembre celebramos el cumpleaños de nuestra Santísima Madre. Todos sabemos que todo el mundo tiene un cumpleaños. La Biblia no dice nada sobre el nacimiento de María, pero sabemos que nació. Como todos los padres, los padres de María fueron Joaquín y Ana y tomaron a su hija como algo especial. Joaquín y Ana amaban mucho a Dios y estaban llenos de gratitud hacia Dios por el regalo de su hija. Criaron a María como una hija de Dios, enseñándole a amar y servir a Dios. Cuando el ángel Gabriel le dijo a María que había sido elegida para ser la madre de Jesús, ella ya tenía una gran fe en Dios. Su fuerte fe y confianza le permitió decir que sí al plan de Dios para ella. No podemos estar seguros de lo que depara el futuro para cualquier recién nacido, pero sabemos que la vida de cada persona tiene un significado y un propósito. Cuando nació María, el mundo no sabía quién era, pero ahora todo el mundo sabe que es la madre de Jesús. Hoy da gracias a Dios por el don de la vida y honra tanto a María como a Jesús mostrando respeto y preocupación el uno por el otro, recordando que Dios ha creado a cada persona con amor y con un llamado a algo muy especial en la vida.

Las fiestas de los santos se celebran tradicionalmente el día de su muerte, porque esa es la fecha en la que entraron a la vida eterna. Y, de hecho, también celebramos la entrada al cielo de la Santísima Virgen María el 15 de agosto, fiesta de la Asunción.

Solo hay tres personas cuyos cumpleaños han sido celebrados tradicionalmente por cristianos. Jesucristo, en Navidad; San Juan bautista; y la Santísima Virgen María. Y celebramos los tres cumpleaños por la misma razón: los tres nacieron sin el pecado original. Cristo, porque fue concebido por el Espíritu Santo. María se mantuvo libre de la mancha del Pecado Original por la acción de Dios en su conocimiento previo de que ella estaría de acuerdo en ser la madre de Cristo; y San Juan, porque fue bendecido en el vientre por la presencia de su Salvador cuando María, embarazada de Jesús, vino a ayudar a su prima Isabel en los últimos meses del embarazo de Isabel (evento que celebramos en la Fiesta de la Visitación).

Gracias una vez más por todo lo que hacen por la parroquia.
