Dear Parishioners,

Greetings to you from Fr. John Peter Swaminathan. Hope you are all doing well. On September 29th the Church celebrated the feast of Archangels. Therefore, it is good to know who they are and what they do.

Saint Michael the Archangel is an angel, and the leader of all angels and of the army of God. This is what the title "Archangel" means, that he is above all the others in rank. Saint Michael is the "Prince of the Heavenly Host." Saint Michael has four main responsibilities or offices, as we know from scripture and Christian tradition.

The first is to combat Satan.

The second is to escort the faithful to heaven at their hour of death.

The third is to be a champion of all Christians, and the Church itself.

The fourth is to call men from life on Earth to their heavenly judgment.

Saint Gabriel is an angel who serves as a messenger for God to certain people. He is one of the three archangels. Gabriel is mentioned in both the Old and the New Testaments of the Bible. In the New Testament, Gabriel, described as "an angel of the Lord," first appears to Zacharias, the father of John the Baptist. He tells him, "Fear not, Zacharias: for thy prayer is heard; and thy wife Elisabeth shall bear thee a son, and thou shalt call his name John. And thou shalt have joy and gladness; and many shall rejoice at his birth. Gabriel told Mary she would conceive from The Holy Ghost and the baby will be the Son of God.

Saint Raphael is one of the seven Archangels who stand before the throne of the Lord, and one of the only three mentioned by name in the Bible. He appears, by name, only in the Book of Tobit. Raphael's name means "God heals." This identity came about because of the biblical story that claims he "healed" the earth when it was defiled by the sins of the fallen angels in the apocryphal book of Enoch. The demon Asmodeus killed every man Sarah married on the night of the wedding, before the marriage could be consummated. Raphael guided Tobiah and taught him how to safely enter the marriage with Sarah. Raphael is credited with driving the evil spirit from Sarah and restoring Tobit's vision, allowing him to see the light of Heaven and for receiving all good things through his intercession. Because of the healing powers often linked to Raphael, the angel spoken of is generally associated with Saint Raphael, the Archangel.

May these archangels guide us and protect us in our journey of life. Thank You once again for all that you do for the Parish.

Estimados feligreses,

Saludos de parte del P. John Peter Swaminathan. Espero que estén todos bien. El 29 de septiembre la Iglesia celebró la fiesta de los Arcángeles. Por tanto, es bueno saber quiénes son y qué hacen.

San Miguel Arcángel es un ángel y el líder de todos los ángeles del ejército de Dios. "Arcángel" significa, que está por encima de todos los demás en rango. San Miguel es el "Príncipe de la Hostia Celestial". San Miguel tiene cuatro responsabilidades u oficios principales, como sabemos por las escrituras y la tradición cristiana.

El primero es combatir a Satanás.

El segundo es acompañar a los fieles al cielo en la hora de su muerte.

El tercero es ser un campeón de todos los cristianos y de la Iglesia misma.

Y el cuarto es llamar a los hombres que tienen vida en la tierra a su juicio celestial.

San Gabriel es un ángel que sirve como mensajero de Dios para ciertas personas. Es uno de los tres arcángeles. Gabriel se menciona tanto en el Antiguo como en el Nuevo Testamento de la Biblia. En el Nuevo Testamento, Gabriel, es descrito como "un ángel del Señor", aparece por primera vez a Zacarías, el padre de Juan el Bautista. Él le dice: Zacarías, no temas; porque tu oración ha sido oída; y tu mujer Isabel dará a luz un hijo, y le daras por nombre Juan. Y tendrás gozo y alegría, y muchos se regocijarán en su nacimiento. Gabriel le dijo a María que concebiría del Espíritu Santo y que el bebé sería el Hijo de Dios.

San Rafael es uno de los siete Arcángeles que están ante el trono del Señor, y uno de los únicos tres mencionados por su nombre en la Biblia. Aparece, por su nombre, solo en el Libro de Tobías. El nombre de Rafael significa "Dios sana". Esta identidad surgió debido a la historia bíblica que afirma que él "sanó" la tierra cuando fue contaminada por los pecados de los ángeles caídos en el libro apócrifo de Enoc. El demonio Asmodeo mató a todos los hombres con los que Sarah se casó la noche de la boda, antes de que el matrimonio pudiera consumarse. Rafael guió a Tobías y le enseñó cómo entrar de forma segura en el matrimonio con Sarah. A Rafael se le atribuye haber expulsado el espíritu maligno de Sarah y restaurar la visión de Tobit, permitiéndole ver la luz del cielo y recibir todas las cosas buenas a través de su intercesión. Debido a los poderes curativos que a menudo se le atribuyen a Rafael, el ángel del que se habla se asocia generalmente con San Rafael, el Arcángel.

Que estos arcángeles nos guíen y protejan en nuestro camino por la vida. Gracias una vez más por todo lo que hacen por la parroquia.
