Masses: The Church celebrates the Feast of Our Lady of Rosary on October 7th. On this day, we celebrate the Holy League's defeat of the Ottoman Empire in the battle of Lepanto on October 7th, 1571. Even though the Turkish forces were very powerful, the Christians won due to the intercession of Mary and the prayer of the Most Holy Rosary.

Our Lady of Victory is also called Our Lady of Rosary. It is the Feast of our Parish. Since this year it falls on Thursday, we will have the celebrations on **Sunday, October 10th**, following the English and Spanish Masses. Lunch will be served in the Parish Hall, prepared by parish organizations. There will be inflatables for the children to play.

The Menu: German/Polish Sausage, Sauerkraut, potatoes and green beans (*Knights of Columbus*) - Tacos, Fruit cups, Philly cheese steak- (*Ministerio Latino*) -Beef enchiladas and Chicken flautas (*Charismatic Group*).

Dear Parishioners,

Greetings to you from Fr. John Peter Swaminathan. Hope you are all doing well.

Growing in a traditional catholic family, I remember as a small boy saying two rosaries every day, that is one in the church every evening and the other at our home after the dinner before going to bed. I was forced by my mother to say the rosary sometimes when I was sleepy as well. We celebrate our parish feast this weekend therefore, we have every right to come together as a parish community to celebrate our presence. There will be lunch cooked and served by the parish organizations in the Parish Hall immediately following the English and Spanish Mass on October 10th. Please join us for this celebration and celebrate our parish festival. There will be inflatables for the children to play and to have fun.

The story of the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary is an interesting one. In the 16th century Pope Pius V was having trouble with the Ottoman Turks, who were a real danger to Christianity. After months of disagreements and bickering, he was able to unite Spain, Venice, and the States of the Church in a naval expedition to fight the Turks.

The two navies met in the Gulf of Lepanto in Greece on October 7, 1571. On the same day, the Rosary Confraternity of Rome was meeting at the Dominican headquarters there. The group recited the Rosary for the special intention of the Christians at battle. The Christians defeated the Turks in a spectacular victory and believed it was the intercessory power of the Blessed Virgin that won the victory. Pope Pius V dedicated the day as one of thanksgiving to Our Lady of Victory. Pope Gregory XIII later changed the name to the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. The story of the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary focuses on the intercessory power of Mary. It shows that when Christians are in danger, they can go to Mary, and when an individual is in pain, discouraged, or having trouble accepting God's will, he or she can also go to Mary. She will pray to her Son for anyone who calls on her. Anyone who prays to Mary no longer feels alone because she prays with them and for them. Mary encouraged praying the rosary in her apparitions. At Lourdes when she appeared to Saint Bernadette, Mary had a rosary. As Bernadette prayed it, Mary joined in on the Glory Be prayers. At Fatima Mary exhorted the three children who saw her to pray the rosary for peace.

Thank You once again for all that you do for the Parish.

Estimados feligreses,

Saludos de parte del P. John Peter Swaminathan. Espero que estén todos bien.

Creciendo en una familia católica tradicional, recuerdo cuando era un niño rezando dos rosarios todos los días, es decir, uno en la iglesia cada noche y el otro en nuestra casa después de la cena antes de ir a la cama. Mi madre me obligaba a rezar el rosario a veces también cuando tenía sueño. Celebramos nuestra fiesta parroquial este fin de semana. Por lo tanto, tenemos todo el derecho a unirnos como comunidad parroquial para celebrar nuestra presencia. Habrá venta de comida preparada y servida por las organizaciones parroquiales en el salón parroquial inmediatamente después de la misa en inglés y español el 10 de octubre. Únase a nosotros para esta celebración y celebre nuestro festival parroquial. Habrá brincolines para que los niños jueguen y se diviertan.

La historia de la fiesta de Nuestra Señora del Rosario es interesante. En el siglo XVI, el Papa Pío V tenía problemas con los turcos otomanos, que eran un peligro real para el cristianismo. Después de meses de desacuerdos y disputas, pudo unir a España, Venecia y los Estados de la Iglesia en una expedición naval para luchar contra los turcos.

Las dos armadas se reunieron en el Golfo de Lepanto en Grecia el 7 de octubre de 1571. Ese mismo día, la Cofradía del Rosario de Roma se reunía en la sede dominicana. Allí el grupo rezó el Rosario por la especial intención de los cristianos en la batalla. Los cristianos derrotaron a los turcos en una victoria espectacular y creyeron que fue el poder intercesor de la Santísima Virgen el que obtuvo la victoria. El Papa Pío V dedicó el día como acción de gracias a Nuestra Señora de la Victoria. El Papa Gregorio XIII luego cambió el nombre a la fiesta de Nuestra Señora del Rosario. La historia de la fiesta de Nuestra Señora del Rosario se centra en el poder intercesor de María. Muestra que cuando los cristianos están en peligro, pueden acudir a María y cuando una persona siente dolor, está desanimada o tiene problemas para aceptar la voluntad de Dios, también puede acudir a María. Ella rezará a su Hijo por quien la llame. Quien reza a María ya no se siente solo porque ella reza con ellos y por ellos. María animó a rezar el Rosario en sus apariciones. En Lourdes, cuando se apareció a santa Bernardita, María tenía un rosario. Mientras Bernardita lo rezaba, María se unió a las oraciones de Gloria. En Fátima, María exhortó a los tres niños que la vieron a rezar el Rosario por la paz.

Gracias una vez más por todo lo que hacen por la parroquia.
