



2020 First Communion Attire

Sunday, August 30, 2020 at 1 pm

(Rehearsal is on Saturday, August 29th at 10 am)

The primary recommendation for First Communion attire at St. Anthony is simple:

Boys and girls should wear their best, conventional and time-honored clothing that does not distract others by attracting undue attention to themselves.

Traditionally Girls Wear:

- White or neutral dresses
- White anklets or white tights
- White shoes
- Veils or head pieces are optional
- Gloves may be worn for pictures - but not during Mass

Traditionally Boys Wear:

- Either suits or dark dress slacks
- White or neutral dress shirt and tie
- Dress shoes

Boys and girls may not wear:

- Jeans
- shorts
- t-shirts
- flip-flops
- Bright/neon or otherwise distracting clothing

Seating arrangements:

- First Communicants will be seated as a group in reserved front pews,
- They will observe social distancing.
- As of early July, it is thought that masks will be optional. Only time will tell.
- Parents will be seated in the pews immediately behind the First Communion candidates.
- Extended family members will be seated on a first come, first available basis.
