Different as they were in temperament, social, cultural, and religious origin, Peter and Paul share a number of similar characteristics: One denied his Master during his passion, while the other persecuted Jesus in the persons of His disciples. The former was attached to the old, reassuring institutions, but did not resist the Spirit who upset his convictions, and led him where he did not want to go. The latter resolutely turned to the nations, but was torn within by the resistance of his own people. Won over by Christ, to Whom they gave their faith and their love, both gave the supreme witness of martyrdom. In them, the Church sees what it should and would be, by its faith and its love of Christ, and its mission.
