DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME - comes to a close next Sunday morning, November 2nd, at 2 AM. Unfortunately, we lose an hour of sleep during this transition - but it also means that Saturday evening Mass at St. Therese reverts back to 5:00 PM, which seems to be most people's preference. 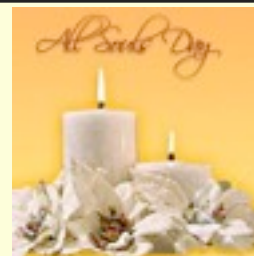
