While he was here, he asked me to become a member of our Parish Commission, and I accepted the invitation. It will require my traveling to an occasional meeting - but I saw it as a healthy and helpful way to make sure that our rural parishes were included in discussions about future plans regarding Carmelite ministries. Please continue to pray for Fr. Bill and his Council in their challenging work!

**SPECIAL COLLECTION** - Thank you for your most generous response to last week's collection for World Missions. It is most appreciated and will help to continue the Church's work of evangelization.

**TIME CHANGE COMING** - Daylight Savings Time comes to an end in the wee hours of next Sunday morning, November 1st. Don't forget to change your clocks - and remember that the Saturday evening vigil Mass at St. Therese will return to 5:00 PM on Saturday, November 7th. Please spread the word!

**NOVEMBER, MONTH OF ALL SOULS** - There are several reminders regarding our observance of All Souls Month: **#1: The Book of Memories will be available in each church beginning next weekend and throughout the month. Feel free to inscribe names of deceased loved ones. During the weekend Masses, these books will be placed on the altar at the time of the Offertory, and the people whose names are held within will be included in our prayer that week.** **#2:** In your packet of envelopes, there is a blue envelope (dated November 1st) for Annual Cemetery Upkeep. There will NOT be a special collection for these donations. If you wish to make an offering, please use this envelope (or any envelope with "Cemetery" and your name and/or envelope number on it) and place it in the regular collection any time during the month of November - and Thank You for your generosity! **#3: Next Sunday, November 1st, we will have our annual Memorial Service in the Cemetery at 2:00 PM. We will remember all those who were buried in our Cemetery since last November and will pray the Rosary for the repose of their souls. If we should have inclement weather, we will gather in St. Boniface Church. Please pass this information on to others!**

**NEW LITURGICAL CALENDARS HAVE ARRIVED** - Mass requests must be made in writing, or made in person at the parish office. If you try to reach me on the phone for a Mass, please just leave a message and a phone number and I will return your call for the details. Please do not leave the Mass intention information on the answering machine. Written requests may be left in the Offertory basket. Masses for a given date are on a first come, first served basis. If you want a Mass on a particular day, make your request sooner rather than later. To be fair to other parishioners, I will only accept 2 (two) Mass intentions from an individual or a family for Saturday evening or Sunday Masses until February 29, 2016. After that date, I will do my best to honor additional requests for weekend Masses. **No Mass offerings or intentions** will be taken for Christmas Eve or Christmas Day, New Years' Eve or New Years' Day, Holy Thursday (March 24th), Easter Vigil or Easter Sunday (March 26th & 27th), Mothers' Day weekend (May 7th & 8th), Fathers' Day weekend (June 18th & 19th), or Thanksgiving Day (November 24th). Mass stipends (\$10) may be made in cash, or by check made out to St. Boniface or St. Therese - not to Frs. Jerry or Dave. Thanks!

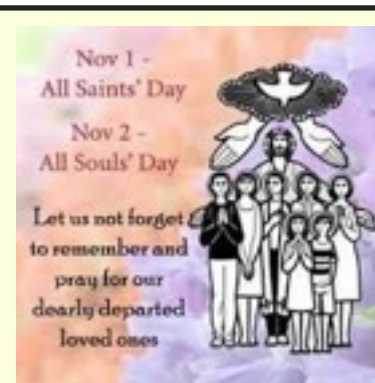
