ADVENT - begins next weekend, along with the new Liturgical Year. The new Breaking Bread hymnals for the year will be in place as of next weekend. We have replaced some of the plastic covers and the Marian Prayer sheet inside the back cover, as well as the Flower of Carmel hymn sheet inside the front cover. Please do your best to keep these intact, as they are meant to be available for the entire year. Also, there will be an Advent and Christmas Meditation book available, one per family, next weekend. Please take one home with you and use it faithfully to prepare for the coming celebration of the Incarnation. As an Archdiocese, we will also be embarking on a concerted effort to participate in the Jubilee Year of Mercy that Pope Francis has called us to celebrate - and more information on how that will be done will be explained next weekend.
