Pastor's Notes

LENT - Rice Bowls are available at the entrance of each church - Collection bins will be available on Passion Sunday - The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available at all the churches in the Archdiocese on Wednesday evenings, from 6 - 7 PM. Locally, Confessions will be at the Priory from 6 - 7 PM on Wednesdays, up until the beginning of CCD classes. Come to the Priory front door! Our Communal Reconciliation Service & Confessions will be on Palm Sunday, March 20th, at 5 PM at St. Boniface. **Stations of the Cross will be on Friday evenings during Lent at 7 PM at St. Therese in Richmond on March 11th; and at St. Boniface in Scipio on March 18th.**

DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME - begins early in the morning of Sunday, March 13th. Don't forget to change your clocks ahead one hour on Saturday evening so you won't be too early for Mass on Sunday - and please remember that Mass at St. Therese on Saturday evenings during Daylight Savings Time returns to 6 PM. The first 6 PM Mass at St. Therese will be on Saturday, March 19th.
