Please remember, **if you plan on coming to the event, please sign the sheets at the entrance of each church** so we can have a headcount for food service.

NEW PROJECTS - As some of you will notice, there are a number of upkeep projects that are or will be happening in both parishes and the Cemetery. Some of these are in response to our insurance carrier recommendations, and others are routine care-taking of aging buildings, grounds, and structures. At St. Therese, new commodes will be installed in both washrooms, as well as a pedestal sink in the upper washroom. Now that the east sidewalk is completed, some yellow highlighting will be added to the walkway. At St. Boniface, three new overhead lights will be installed to provide more illumination for evening gatherings. New de-humidifiers have been installed in the Hall basement, and should greatly assist in air quality in that building. Finally, at least for the moment, the base under the statue of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel to the north of the church needs work. The rock wall is badly damaged, and the entire base is deteriorating and needs repair. In the Cemetery, you may have noticed that the stone sign at the entrance has been capped and cleaned - thanks to the Gus and Bernice Rockers family - and Bernice's name has been added to the dedication plaque. Some additional earth moving is needed to improve drainage under the "bridge", and finally, the Crucifixion scene and altar is in need of repair and restoration. There are several grave markers that are in very poor shape as well. Please check your family or ancestral graves - and if you are in contact with former members who are responsible for any damaged grave markers - please let them know, or inform me and I will try my best to be in touch with them. These are ongoing improvements, and your support of these efforts is very much appreciated!

HOME VISITS - I make weekly visits and bring Holy Communion to our homebound members on Wednesdays, following the Mass at Richmond Healthcare and my Communion calls at Residential Care and Guest Home Estates in Garnett. If you know of anyone who would like for me to stop and visit them on a regular basis or even an occasional visit, please let me know or have them call me. **There will be Mass this week, on 1st Friday, August 5th, at Golden Heights - 10 AM, in the Common Room inside the front entrance. All are welcome to join us for this liturgy.** Let's all keep our elderly, sick and homebound parishioners in our prayers!
