The following information comes from the figures of those pledges that have been made and processed through our parish office as of Monday, February 5th: **St. Therese:** \$1,430 pledged (55.4% of target), by 10 individuals (25% of parishioners), with an average gift of \$143.00. **St. Boniface:** \$1,885.00 pledged (36.5% of target), by 15 individuals (14.8% of parishioners), with an average gift of \$125.66.
