**LENT** - is just around the corner! The Lenten Season begins this week, with Ash Wednesday, March 6th. There will be Masses and Distribution of Ashes at St. Therese on Ash Wednesday at 8:30 AM; at Richmond Healthcare and Rehab at 10:30 AM in the dining room; and at St. Boniface at 7 PM. Distribution of Ashes and a Communion Service will be at Anderson County Hospital Residential Care Facility at approximately 11:30 AM. Lenten meditation books are available this weekend at both churches. There are enough for one per household. There are also two on-line Lenten programs which you may benefit from: Dynamic Catholic is offering its Best Lent Ever program again this year. **FASTING AND ABSTINENCE & RECONCILIATION** - Two of the Precepts of the Church are highlighted during Lent - confession of our sins at least once a year; and observing days of fast and abstinence. Our Penance Service with Individual Confessions will be on Palm Sunday evening, April 14th at 5:00 PM. Reconciliation is available every Saturday from 3 - 3:45 PM in the Sacristy at St. Boniface, or by appointment by calling the parish office. Additional local parish Reconciliation Services will be posted in next weekend's Bulletin. **Ash Wednesday, March 6th** - and **Good Friday, April 19th** are both days of Fasting **and** Abstinence. Fasting is required of those who are 18 and not yet 60 years old, and means eating a lesser amount of food = one full meal with two smaller meals, with no eating between meals. Abstinence means not eating any meat and is required of all who are 14 years of age and older. While Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of both Fasting and Abstinence, **all Fridays during Lent** are days of Abstinence.

**STATIONS OF THE CROSS AND K OF C FISH DINNERS** - On the evenings when Garnett Knights hold their fish dinners, Stations will be at St. Therese at 7 PM - March 8th, 22nd, and April 5th. When Greeley holds theirs, Stations will be at 7 PM at St. Boniface on March 15th, 29th, and April 12th.

**CANCELLATIONS** - Hopefully the worst of winter storms are behind us - but for future reference, if there is inclement weather or some other reason for weekend Masses or other events to be cancelled, an announcement will be posted on the parish website. We are hoping to also communicate with a blast email or text.
