FASTING AND ABSTINENCE & RECONCILIATION - Two of the Precepts of the Church are highlighted during Lent - confession of our sins at least once a year; and observing days of fast and abstinence. Our Penance Service with Individual Confessions will be on Palm Sunday evening, April 14th at 5:00 PM. Reconciliation is available every Saturday from 3 - 3:45 PM in the Sacristy at St. Boniface, every Wednesday evening from 6 - 7 PM (come to the Priory front door) or by appointment by calling the parish office. While Good Friday is a day of both Fasting and Abstinence, **all Fridays during Lent** are days of Abstinence.
