**2020 MASS INTENTIONS** - Offerings for future Mass intentions are now being accepted. **PLEASE KEEP THE FOLLOWING IN MIND!** The normal stipend for a Mass is \$10.00. Please include the stipend(s) in the envelope that contains your request(s) - and make ALL requests in writing! They may be handed to me, mailed, or placed in the regular collection basket on the weekends. As you will see in next weekend's Bulletin, all stipend money is returned to the respective parish and is not kept by the priest(s). These payments are made to the parishes twice a year, in January and in July. To be fair to everyone, between January 1st and April 1st - you may only ask for 3 weekend (Saturday evening or Sunday morning) Masses for 2020. You may request additional weekend Masses after April 1st - **there will be no exceptions to this!** Please also remember that Wednesday Masses are for all of the parishioners and their intentions; and that Masses at St. Boniface are on Mondays and Fridays; and at St. Therese on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Thank you for your understanding regarding this sometimes sensitive reality, as well as your cooperation with these guidelines!

**CARMELITE STARS** - will be hosting their annual Valentines Day Dinner on Saturday, February 8th, beginning at 6:30 PM. Tickets are on sale now, and are \$20 per ticket. *Stars* and their leaders will be selling tickets at both churches this weekend, January 11th and 12th.
