THE MASS WILL GO PUBLIC AT 5 PM ON SATURDAY, MAY 2ND. HELPERS THIS WEEK WERE MIKE AND MISTY WHEELER, FROM ST. THERESE IN RICHMOND, AND WE ALL EXPRESS OUR GRATITUDE TO THEM FOR LENDING A HAND! IF THERE SHOULD BE NEED FOR ANOTHER ON LINE MASS NEXT WEEKEND, AND YOU WOULD LIKE TO BE THE LECTOR OR CAMERA OPERATOR, PLEASE DROP ME A NOTE OR GIVE ME A CALL BY MONDAY NIGHT. THANKS FOR CONSIDERING THIS REQUEST. TO CONNECT WITH THE ON LINE MASS, GO TO OUR WEB PAGE AND CLICK ON THE LINK ON THE HOME PAGE OF THE SITE.

FOR ANY EMERGENCIES, PLEASE CALL THE PARISH NUMBER AND IF I AM NOT AVAILABLE, PLEASE LEAVE A MESSAGE AND I WILL RETURN YOUR CALL AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE.

I WAS JUST NOTIFIED ABOUT A CONFERENCE CALL WITH ARCHBISHOP NAUMANN ON TUESDAY, MAY 5TH, THAT WILL ADDRESS HOW WE MOVE FORWARD AS WE PREPARE FOR RETURN TO "NORMAL". THERE ARE MANY QUESTIONS THAT MUST BE ANSWERED AND PLANS TO BE MADE BEFORE THAT OCCURS. PLEASE KEEP CHECKING OUR OWN WEBSITE AS WELL AS THE ARCHDIOCESAN WEBSITE AS THESE PLANS ARE REVEALED. I WILL ALSO SEND OUT BLAST E MAILS TO OFFER YOU THE BEST INFORMATION I CAN AND AS QUICKLY AS I CAN. WE HAVE BEEN TOLD THAT THE VERY EARLIEST MASSES COULD POSSIBLY RETURN WOULD BE NEXT WEEKEND - BUT THAT HAS NOT BEEN DETERMINED YET! IF THAT TURNS OUT NOT TO BE THE CASE, MASS WILL BE AVAILABLE ON LINE, EITHER THROUGH OUR OWN SITE OR THE MANY OTHERS THAT HAVE BEEN AVAILABLE ALL ALONG. AGAIN, I'LL LET YOU KNOW THAT AS QUICKLY AS I CAN. HOWEVER, THERE ARE SOME THINGS THAT WE CAN BEGIN TO DO NOW, THAT WILL BE HELPFUL FOR WHENEVER IT IS THAT WE GATHER TOGETHER AS A FAITH COMMUNITY. PLEASE START THINKING ABOUT AND PREPARING FOR THE FOLLOWING:

EVERYONE WILL NEED TO HAVE AND TO WEAR A FACE MASK. IT WOULD BE MOST HELPFUL IF YOU BRING YOUR OWN. IT WOULD ALSO BE VERY HELPFUL IF WE WERE TO HAVE A GOOD SUPPLY OF EXTRAS FOR THOSE WHO HAVE NOT COME PREPARED - SO IF YOU HAVE BEEN MAKING THEM AT HOME AND WOULD LIKE TO DONATE SOME TO THE CHURCHES, IT WOULD BE APPRECIATED.

WE WILL NEED TO HAVE A HEALTHY SUPPLY OF HAND-SANITIZERS AND DISPENSERS AT EVERY DOOR OF THE CHURCHES. IF YOU RUN ACROSS LARGE DISPENSERS WHEN YOU ARE SHOPPING, PLEASE PURCHASE THEM AND GIVE ME YOUR RECEIPTS FOR REIMBURSEMENT. KINDLY LET ME KNOW IF YOU WILL BE DOING THIS SO I CAN GET THEM IN PLACE AHEAD OF TIME!

THERE IS THE POSSIBILITY THAT AN EXTRA MASS OR TWO MAY HAVE TO BE ADDED FOR THE DURATION OF THE PHASED-IN RETURN TO NORMAL PERIOD ONLY. IT IS CONCEIVABLE THAT YOU WILL BE TOLD WHICH MASS TO ATTEND SO THERE IS SOME CONTROL OVER THE NUMBERS IN ATTENDANCE. AS AWKWARD AS THAT MAY SEEM, IT IS CERTAINLY BETTER THAN ARRIVING AT CHURCH AND BEING TOLD THERE IS NO ROOM FOR YOU!

THERE WILL ALSO BE THE NEED FOR SOCIAL DISTANCING BOTH WHILE ENTERING AND EXITING THE CHURCH, AND IN SEATING DURING MASS AND WHEN RECEIVING COMMUNION. WHAT FORM THAT WILL TAKE WILL HAVE TO BE DETERMINED - BUT PLEASE BE PATIENT AND UNDERSTANDING OF THOSE WHO WILL BE GUIDING YOU IN THIS ARRANGEMENT.

FINALLY (FOR THE MOMENT!), CALLS WILL SOON BE GOING OUT TO VOLUNTEERS FROM BOTH PARISHES TO ASK FOR YOUR ASSISTANCE IN A THOROUGH CLEANING OF BOTH CHURCHES BEFORE WE ALL RETURN.
