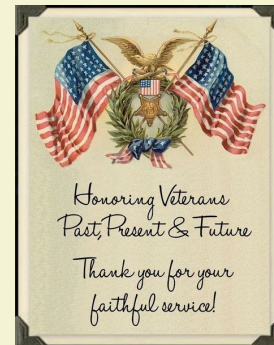
Thank you - to all who contributed to the **Bazaar/Deficit Reduction Appeal!** Here are the numbers as of last weekend: Total donations offered and gratefully received: \$12,455.00 (our target was \$12,000.00). \$500.00 of that was offered from 3 donors outside of the parish. \$11,955.00 came from 62 donors (56% of our registered members) of St. Boniface, making for an average gift of \$200.88. I can't begin to thank you enough for your generosity and the outpouring of support during this difficult and challenging year that has affected all of us in one way or another.
