**What is a Monsignor?**  
As early as the 14th century, it was the custom to address persons of high rank or power with the title "Monsignor." As used by the Church, this title implies a distinction bestowed on a priest by the highest ecclesiastical authority, either in conjunction with a specific office or else merely an honorific title. A priest is presented by his bishop to the Pope for this distinction. It is common in recent years for this distinction to be given to a priest in honor of his long life of good and faithful ministry. Some bishops put forward a priest to be made monsignor on account of the office that priest holds (e.g. rector of a major seminary). A monsignor is not a separate order of the priesthood, and monsignors do not "outrank" other priests in fact, though perhaps in dignity and honor. Part of the dignity and honor of monsignor, as manifested particularly in the liturgy, is that monsignors are permitted their own clerical dress: they may wear fuchsia cassocks or black cassocks trimmed with fuchsia accents, similar to those of bishops; whereas priests wear all-black cassocks.

To illustrate by a comparison, *monsignor* in the spiritual order corresponds to the word *officer* in the military. The highest general and the youngest lieutenant are equally officers, and the most venerable patriarch bears the title monsignor as well as the simplest honorary chaplain. Thus, among prelates, both higher and lower, it is not really a badge of distinction except insofar as it denotes in a very general way an elevation above the ranks of the clergy.

In the Diocese of Spokane, until recently, we have had a fair number of monsignors. Due to the passing of some of our older monsignors, there are now five monsignors serving in our Diocese, one of whom is Msgr. Robert Pearson, who is substituting for Fr. Jeff at all the Masses while Fr. Jeff is at the Catholic Engaged Encounter retreat at the Immaculate Heart Retreat Center. Welcome, Msgr. Pearson!
