Mass will be held at **The Truth About Demons**. All are invited to attend! Hollywood and pop culture myths about demonic possession and the supernatural becoming more and more abundant, Christians must be cautioned to avoid sensationalistic and spiritually dangerous attitudes towards the supernatural. Popular interest in the occult seems to be at an all-time high, and even Pope Francis has been warning us more and more about demonic influence. There is a need, therefore, for a careful corrective to the hype found both outside and inside the Church and to be made aware of the very real and quickly growing phenomena of reported demonic attacks and the upstart devil-fighting ministries that claim to ward them off. A lot of people are over-emotional on this subject. Many more see demons and the supernatural as some sort of game. We need to sift through all of that and get to a sober, objective look — from Church teaching and the testimony of working exorcists. Part of that objectivity involves the ability to distinguish between mental illness and demonic influence. Chronic mental and emotional problems may be exacerbated by demons because the devil likes to attack us where we are weakest. But not every problem has a demon behind it. Such prudent discernment is too often lacking in so-called "deliverance ministries," which place undue emphasis on "spiritual warfare" against extraordinary demonic attacks and not enough in the less sensational way that most of us encounter the devil's influence — in the daily temptations to sin. Every once in a while, Satan is the great dragon of the Book of Revelation; but most of the time, he is just a little whispering serpent trying to steer us away from following God's will. Catholic spiritual practices and prayer are our best bet; they instill in us the grace and virtuous habits that are the ordinary — and for most of us the best — defense against demons.
