### Annual Catholic Appeal Update

As of February 8<sup>th</sup>, St. Mary of the Rosary has pledged \$24,449 in the Annual Catholic Appeal for the Diocese of Spokane (or 97.47% of the goal of \$25,136) with 45.7% family participation. Holy Ghost Parish has pledged \$6610 (or 105.62% of the goal of \$6,258) with 62.50% participation. Sacred Heart has pledged \$2,700 (or 100.86% of the goal of \$2,677) with 50% participation.
