Diocese-Wide ERC Network

In February, St. John Vianney Knights of Columbus (Spokane) began an Emergency Response [two-way radio] Communication (ERC) network to help parishioners communicate with each other when the electrical-grid goes down, due to natural or man-made disasters, such as windstorms, ice-storms, wildfires, train derailments, or acts of terrorism. We now have an Amateur Radio ERC network and a GMRS ERC network established, and we communicate on them for training and equipment testing each week.
